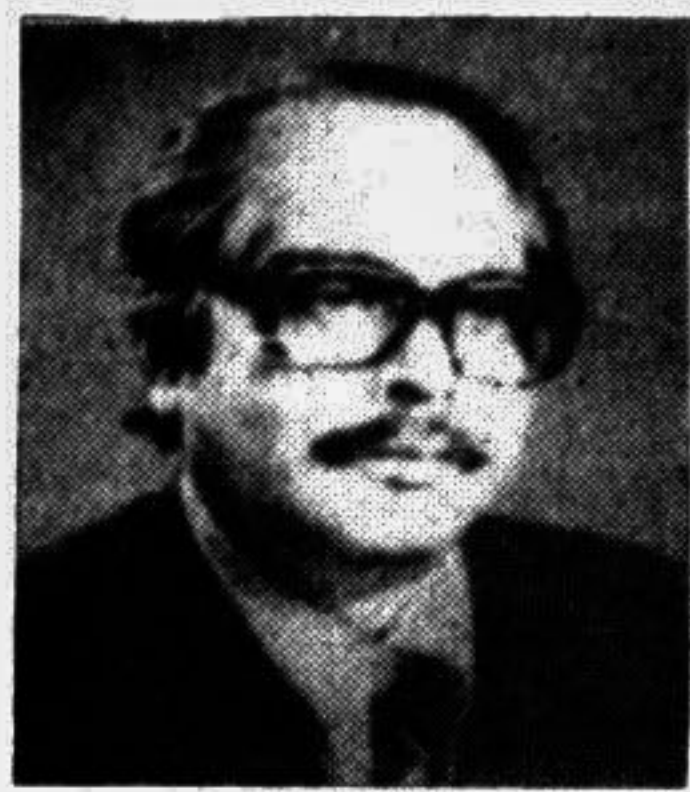

**BA regional cargo manager in city**

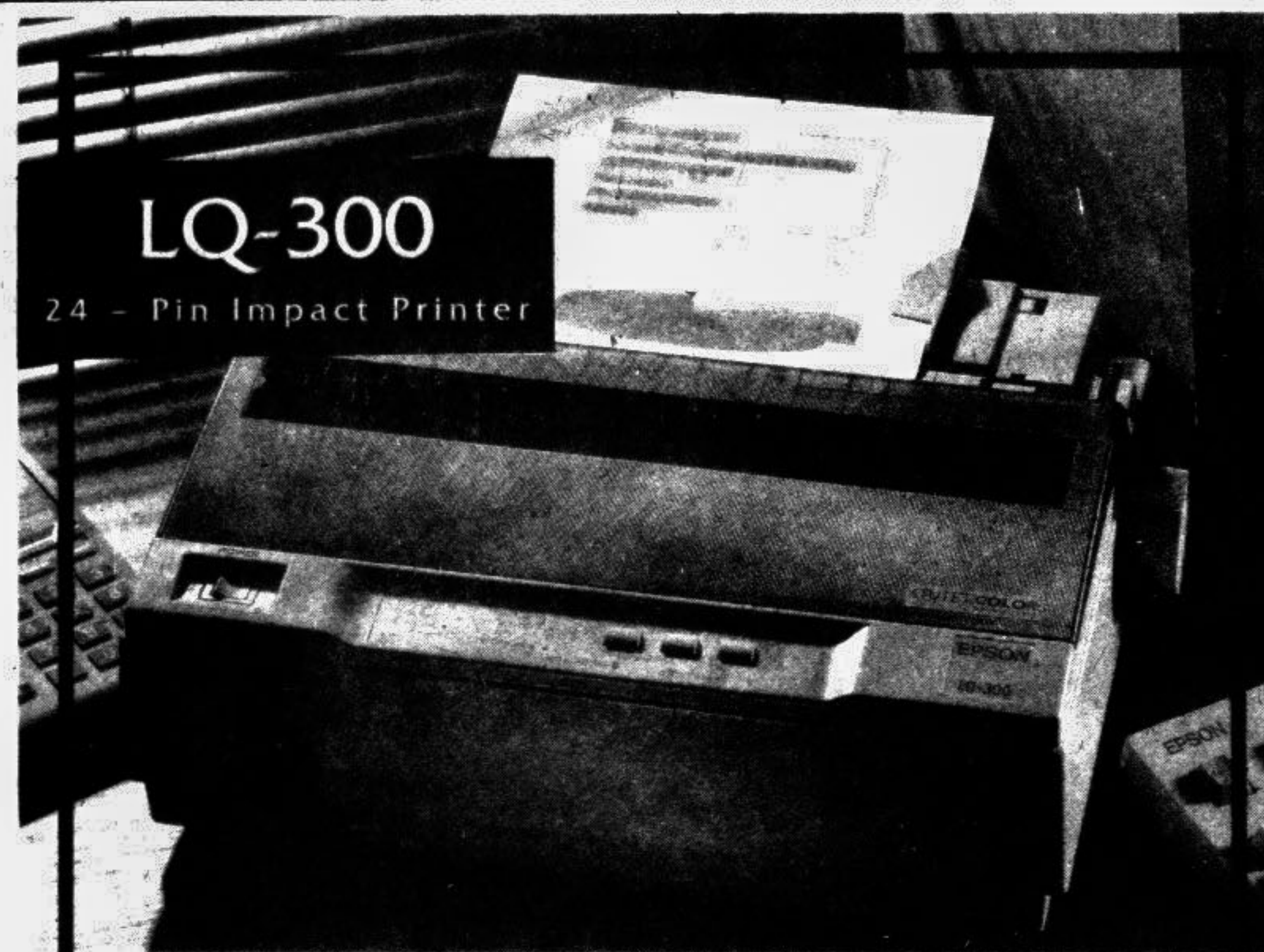
