New Lankan HC meets Khaleda

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia yesterday said, the country is eagerly awaiting to receive Sri Lankan President Chandrika Kumaratunga in Bangladesh, reports UNB.

Begum Zia said this to newly appointed Sri Lankan High Commissioner in Dhaka SB Atugoda who made his first call on the Prime Minister at her office in the morning.

Sri Lankan President Chandrika Kumaratunga is scheduled to pay a three-day visit to Bangladesh beginning March 28.

Talking to the High Commissioner, Begum Zia termed the relations between Bangladesh and Sri Lanka as excellent and said, the ensuing visit of President Kumaratunga would further develop the existing bilateral ties...

Welcoming the new high commissioner, the Prime Minister expressed the hope that he would work for further improving relations between the two countries.

She assured Atugoda of all-out cooperation during his stay in Bangladesh.

The Lankan high commissioner told the Prime Minister that he would take more effective steps to increase bilateral relations between Sri Lanka and Bangladesh.
