A plaque in memory of the martyred intellectuals, students, employees of Dhaka University was unveiled on the Independence Day, Sunday, in the city, reports UNB.

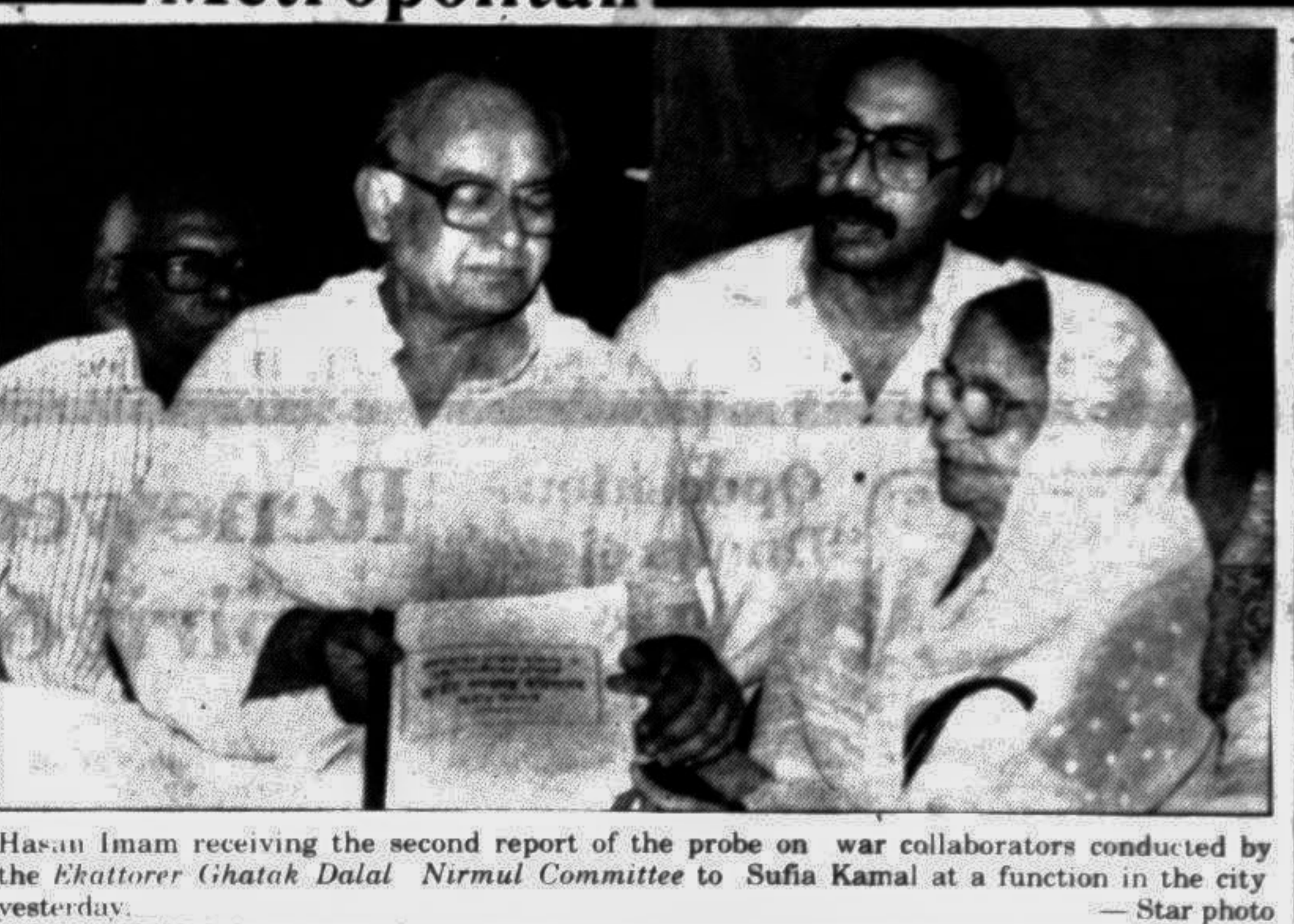
Lilli Chowdhury, wife of martyred Munir Chowdhury, unveiled the plaque at the triangular island in front of the VC's official residence.

A large number of teachers, students and employees of the university were present on the occasion.

Names of 19 teachers 101 students, nine officials, 28 employees, embraced martyrdom during the 1971 War of Liberation, have been engraved on the plaque.

Speaking on the occasion DU Vice Chancellor Emajuddin Ahmed said, *shaheeds* of the Liberation War are the greatest sons of the soil.

We have been able to establish an independent and sovereign country on the world map following their (martyrs) supreme sacrifice, he said urging all to come forward to materialise the dreams of the martyrs.

The students of the hall met the Vice Chancellor of the university yesterday afternoon to discuss the matter, sources said.

Independence Day observed in Ctg, Khulna

CHITTAGONG, Mar 27: Independence and National Day was observed here as elsewhere in the country yesterday with great enthusiasm and eclat, reports BSS.

Political parties, student, socio-cultural and trade organisations and educational institutions took up elaborate programme including placing of wreaths at the *shaheed* *minar*, hoisting of national flag atop all public and private buildings, discussions on the significance of the Independence Day and cultural functions, *miad mahfil* and special prayers.

The district administration also planned a day-long programme in this connection which included march past by police, *ansars*, VDP, boys scout, BNCC, and school boys and girls.

Chittagong divisional commissioner *Shafiqul Islam* took salute at the march past.

Another BSS report adds: The Independence and National Day was observed in Khulna as elsewhere in the country with a renewed pledge for strengthening the hard earned independence and sovereignty and consolidating the democratic process in the country.

Various political and socio-cultural organisations took elaborate programmes in observance of the day in a befitting manner.

The day's programmes heralded with 21-gun salute at midnight at the Khulna collectorate premises. The programmes included hoisting of national flags atop all private and public buildings, march past by police, *ansars*, VDP, BNCC, rovers, fire service and civil defence and students. Commissioner, Khulna Division took salute at the march past and formally hoisted the national flag at the Khulna Stadium.

The Independence and National Day was observed in Narayanganj with much eclat.

The day's programme was heralded with the booming of 21-gun salute early in the morning.

The national flag was hoisted atop all public and private buildings. Different socio-cultural and political organisations placed wreaths at *Chashara shaheed* *minar* to pay respect to the martyrs of the War of Liberation.

A youth rally was held at *Chashara Osmany Stadium* at 8 am.
