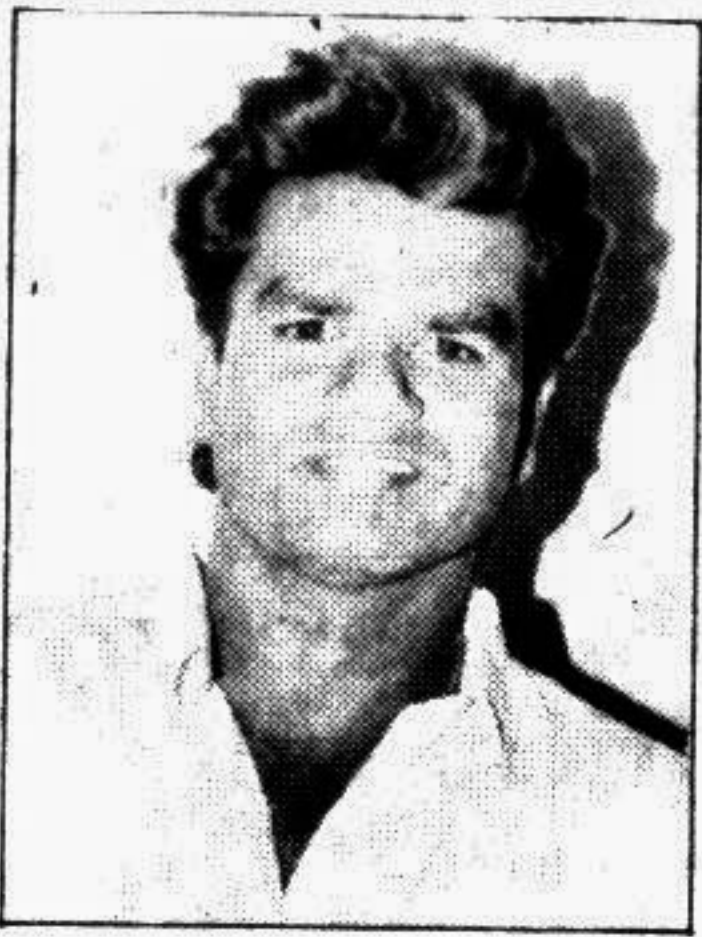


WASIM HAIDER... 88

Charlton for rematch with England

DUBLIN, Mar 29: Ireland soccer manager Jack Charlton called on Wednesday for the match against England abandoned last month because of crowd violence to be restaged, reports Reuter.

Several people were injured and 40 arrested as fighting flared midway through the first half, spilling on to the pitch and halting play in the worst display of soccer violence seen in Dublin.

But writing in the programme for Wednesday's Ireland versus Northern Ireland European Championship qualifier, Charlton said: "I would dearly love the match to be replaced as soon as possible to prove to those 'thugs' that they are never going to win the day."

Clinton, Gore speak to Atlanta Games organisers

ATLANTA, Mar 29: Be it college hoops or a jog around the park, President Clinton loves sports. And when the biggest show comes to town next year, the United States' First Fan will be there cheering, reports AP.

Kicking off a two-day Atlanta visit by speaking to a large crowd of Olympic employees and volunteers, Clinton and Vice-President Al Gore recalled that President Hoover refused to participate in the 1932 Los Angeles Games.

"This is a great endeavour," Clinton said. "I can't imagine that Herbert Hoover refused to open the Olympics. That's probably why he was a one-termer."

"All this time we've been reading in the history books it was because of the Depression, we find out it was the Olympics."

Clinton, Gore and several Cabinet members are in Atlanta primarily for a regional economic conference on Wednesday. Clinton also was attending a reception at the governor's mansion later Tuesday.

Clinton, who was introduced to thunderous applause from a group of about 800 people that also included employees of the Paralympic Games, offered encouragement to those putting on the Olympics.

"You have no idea what you are doing for the United States," Clinton said.

Clinton noted the Olympic Force, the contingent of thousands of volunteers who are performing community work as a prelude to assisting visitors to the 1996 Games.

Bez another Tapie

BORDEAUX, Mar 29: Claude Bez, the man who tried to expose Bernard Tapie as a match-fixer five years ago, has appealed to the Supreme Court of Appeal after being sentenced to a year's prison for fraud, reports AFP.

The former Bordeaux club president was sentenced to one year's prison and a further two years suspended and fined two million francs (400,000 dollars). The appeal court here also ordered him to repay the local authority 2.5 million francs (500,000 dollars) for overcharging on building work at the club's training centre.

His son Eric, in charge of the project, was given an 18-month sentence, of which 12 months were suspended, and fined 100,000 francs (20,000 dollars).

Bordeaux town hall and the regional authority made a grant of 54 million francs (10 million dollars) for the work of which 12 million francs (two million dollars) were siphoned off by Bez, the court was told.

Bez spent three months on remand last year while investigations into financial irregularities at the club were carried out.

He had accused Tapie of match-fixing in 1990 but the French Football Federation could find no hard proof. Bez had preceded Tapie as the strongest man in French football but the accusation proved to be his downfall.

Tapie has also appealed to the Supreme Court of Appeal against being declared a bankrupt and the hearing was fixed for Friday.
