BBC's new time schedule for local listeners

Avid listeners of the BBC World Service Radio in Bangladesh will, from tomorrow, be able to hear their favourite English-language programmes at times more convenient to them.

From April 1, the radio's existing single global schedule is to be split up into regional streams, with one specifically for the South Asian region, which will then be broadcast at more appropriate local times using the latest digital technology.

For listeners in Bangladesh, the change will create scopes for hearing many more popular BBC programmes on the 100 FM band, between 6:00 am -9:45 am and 4:00pm-11:45 pm in local times.

The new system of scheduling was outlined by the visiting BBC's head of development for English programmes, Mick Delap, at a press conference held on Wednesday in the city. Richard Galpin, the BBC correspondent in Dhaka, was present at the briefing.

Delap also highlighted some new additions to the present programme line-up.

Peak-time early morning sessions will be bolstered with a new 30-minute news and current affairs programme 'Newsday' at 8:00am. 'Breakfast Briefing' at 7:30am and extra editions of 'Newsdesk'. Features and entertainment programmes, regional news round-ups, with South Asia Report at 11pm, will dominate the evening session.
