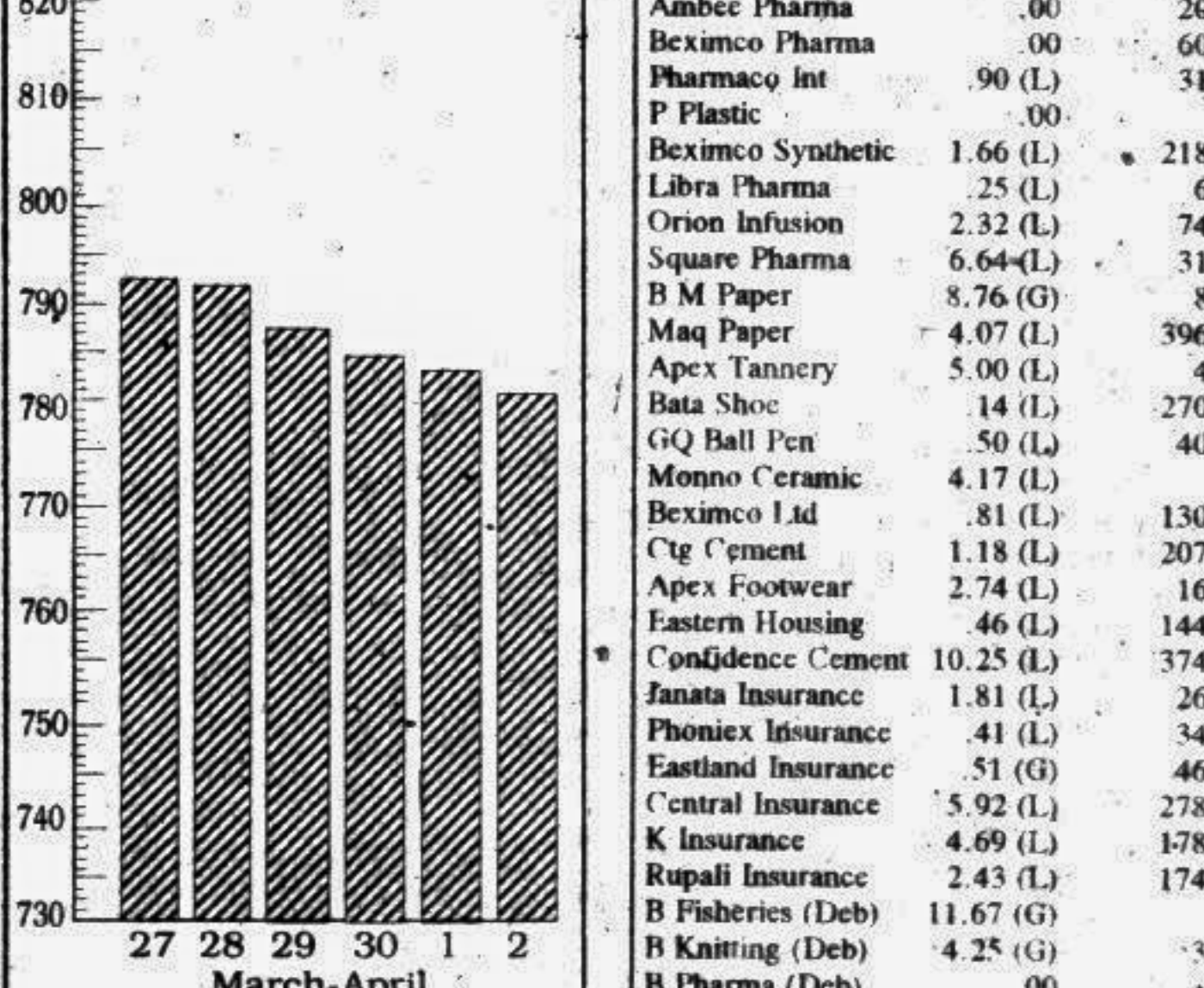

CAIRO, Apr 2: More than 15 million people are unemployed in the Arab world and 2.5 million join their ranks every year, the head of the Arab Labour Organization (ALO) said yesterday, reports AFP.
