Short Term Consultancy Positions
For the Parliament Secretariat

Under the Parliamentary Development Project funded by The Asia Foundation, Dhaka, the following short-term local Consultants will be recruited:

- 1. Manpower Development Consultant (One)—four man-months.
(a) Qualification: The requisite qualifications include an advanced degree in Social Science preferably Public Administration/related discipline and professional background. Experience in curriculum development managing a training institute etc.
(b) Salary: Around Tk 20,000/00 per month.
(c) Job description: The Manpower Development Consultant's specific tasks will be (i) to assist the Secretariat in identifying its specific training requirements; (ii) to devise a training matrix, specifying the combination of in-house courses, in-country classes and seminars, and foreign training attachments that will meet those requirements; (iii) to develop the core curriculum and training aids for the initial in-house course offerings; (iv) to help organise the Manpower Development and Training Unit; (v) to provide specialised methodological training to newly recruited training staff employed in the Unit; and (vi) to establish the criteria and methods by which all of the training programmes can be objectively evaluated.
2. Member Seminar Consultant (One) — three man-months.
(a) Qualification: The requisite qualifications for the Consultant are an advanced degree in Political Science or a relevant public policy field; creditable experience in conducting national, regional, or inter-national conferences and seminars; strong public relations skill, and a functional comparative knowledge of parliamentary systems in general and of Bangladesh's Parliamentary history in particular.
(b) Salary: Around Tk 20,000/00 per month.
(c) Job description: The specific tasks to be undertaken by the consultant are (i) to identify the topics of interest to Members of Parliament to be covered in a comprehensive series of seminars and workshops; (ii) to locate well-qualified national and international figures to moderate and participate as panelists in such programmes; (iii) to liaise closely with the Secretariat in arranging the logistics and conducting the programmes; (iv) to coordinate with the Parliament Secretariat's Research and Documentation Section, the preparation of background materials and information packets for advanced distribution to the participating Members; (v) to edit for public action the papers delivered in the seminars and the summaries of the workshop proceedings; (vi) to establish suitable mechanisms for evaluating the benefits to Members and subsequently institutionalising such orientation and seminar programmes.
3. Computer Database Consultant (One) — four man-months.
(a) Qualification: MSc in Computer Science or a related subject with atleast three years experience in computer programming including responsibility for writing original programme for integrated data processing applications, applied knowledge of MS-DOS, one other commercial operating systems software package, atleast two original or commercial applications software packages and functional knowledge of relational database and sequential query languages. Preferable experience in use of CDS/ISIS software.
(b) Salary: Around Tk. 24,000/00 per month.
(c) Job description: The Computer Database Consultant's tasks will be (i) to code, programme, test, debug, installation of a database programme according to the Library's bibliographic control requirements; (ii) to produce the database documentation including programme specifications, flow charts, block diagrams and test programmes as well as user and system manuals; (iii) to run and maintain the application for a minimum period of 90 days, defining and implementing procedures for data integrity and back-up; (iv) to analyze system operation, malfunctions, user feedback and making necessary modifications in the programme; and (v) to train the library staff in data processing applications using the software produced.
4. Public Policy Consultant (One) — three man-months.
(a) Qualification: The requisite qualifications are an advanced degree in Social Science; substantial experience and national reputation in the respective field; publishing credits in referred professional literature; participation in national, regional and international conferences and seminars; a demonstrated sense of political impartiality in dealing with all Members of Parliamentary Committees in respective of their ideology or political party affiliation; and strong public relation skills.
(b) Salary: Around Tk 20,000/00 per month.
(c) Job description: The specific task to be undertaken by the Consultant will be (i) to undertake highly specialised studies on topics of urgent national priority; (ii) to serve as expert advisor to the committee(s) and assist them to examine in detail major public policy conflicts and problems as and when they arise; (iii) to help and guide the Parliament Secretariat in developing its institutional research capabilities and resources; and (iv) to serve as a bridge between Parliament and the professional communities represented by those selected to serve as specialist advisor to Parliament.
