Int'l cultural evening in city

An international cultural evening was held yesterday at the National Museum auditorium in the city.

Organised jointly by the Foreign Office Wives Association and the Wives of the Diplomatic Corps in Bangladesh in aid of the Women's Voluntary Association Fund, the function was inaugurated by Foreign Minister A S M Mostafizur Rahman.

The foreign minister in his speech said culture was transcendental and it surpasses ethnic, linguistic and all other barriers among nations.

He said it brings people closer and demonstrates unity in diversity. He expressed the hope that such international cultural events would help communities of different countries in Bangladesh to come closer to each other.

GSB discovers minerals worth Tk 6 lakh crore

Geological Survey of Bangladesh (GSB) has so far discovered coal, hardrock, peat coal, limestone and other minerals worth about Tk 6 lakh crore in the country, reports UNB.

This was disclosed at a prize giving function of the GSB in the city yesterday.

Speaking on the occasion, Energy and Mineral Resources Minister Dr Khandakar Mosharrar Hossain said GSB discovered 300 million tons of coal at Barapukuria, 143 million tons at Khalashpir in Rangpur and 1.053 million tons at Jamaiganj in Bogra.

The approximate value of the coal discovered in these places is Tk 4.5 lakh crore, he said.

The minister said coal extraction work is going on at Barapukuria and fund is being mobilised for extracting coal from Khalashpir.

The minister said the present government has strengthened exploratory activities of GSB to find out mineral resources in the country still undiscovered. He said awarding of independence award 94 to GSB has put greater responsibility on the officials and employees of the directorate in materialising the hopes and aspiration of the people.

Faizur Razzak assured GSB of government funding in carrying out exploration works to discover mineral resources.

Pharmacological Society's nat'l convention held

Prof Emajuddin Ahmed, Vice Chancellor of the Dhaka University yesterday urged the teachers and researchers of the physiology and biochemistry to restructure the medical curriculum with a view to create doctors of practical need keeping in mind the priority of medical facilities in the national life.

He was addressing as chief guest at the 6th National Convention of the Bangladesh Physiological and Pharmacological Society at Shaheed Milton Auditorium at Institute of Postgraduate Medicine and Research, Shaahab.

The VC also said that such a step would be a milestone in developing medical science in the country.

Prof Ahmed hoped that the researcher and the teachers of the pharmacology will take effective step for a new generation of efficient doctors by including society related subjects in the syllabus.

He assured that the DU will do everything for the sake of the country and the nation.

Dr Humayun K M A Hye consultant of the World Bank (WB) told the convention as guest of honour that the health status of the people did not solely depend on its income level or prosperity.

He also told that the education and cultural level of a people may even be more important than the availability of health care services in determining its health status.

Among other, the convention were addressed by Prof M A Hal, chairman of the society, Dr Md Zahurul Haque, secretary of the society and Prof Md Suharab Ali.
