

JB giving loan with small interest rate to encourage investment in agri, business

JHENIDAH, Apr 18: Janata Bank (JB) has distributed Taka 3.5 crore for development of socio-economic condition, agriculture, transport system and business in Jhenidah zone during last ten months.

According to official sources, Janata Bank distributed Taka one crore eighty-five lakh as crop loan, Taka 31 lakh as supervision loan, Taka 65 lakh as cash credit (CC) loan and Taka 40 lakh against transport account.

Zonal office sources said the figure of crop loan for Jhenidah district was Taka ninety-nine lakh seventy-five thousand. Until March 31 of this year Taka eighty-one lakh four thousand was distributed.

The allocation for crop loan for Magura district was Taka one crore thirty-nine lakh seventy-five thousand. So far Taka one crore four lakh eighty six

has been distributed. The disbursement rate of the loan was 78 per cent, bank sources said.

To give financial assistance to small traders Janata Bank distributed Taka thirty-one lakh at a reduced interest rate further more Taka 35 lakh was distributed as cash credit and Taka 40 lakh was disbursed against transport sector.

The sources informed that the loans were distributed through 25 branches of Janata Bank under Jhenidah zonal office. Until March 31 of this year, JB has distributed Taka ninety-seven lakh sixty-two thousand only as crop loans.

Talking to the Assistant General Manager (AGM), Janata Bank Jhenidah Zone it was gathered that JB has already reduced the interest rate and loan systems has been simplified.

Poor power supply affects industrial output in Barisal Div

BARISAL, Apr 18: Frequent power disruption in six southern districts under Barisal Division is causing much inconvenience to public life, reports UNB.

People of Barisal, Bhola, Jhalakathi, Protopur, Patuakhali and Barguna have been suffering from this problem for a long time. All industrial units of this region have also been facing serious setback due to the problem.

Official sources said, nearly 40 megawatt power supply is required per day in PDB

Barisal zone, but the current supply is not more than 20 to 30 megawatt.

As a result, load-shedding and power failure has become a regular feature in this region. Sometimes, power disruption continues for hours particularly in peak hours.

The people of Bhola, Patuakhali and Barguna districts are the worst sufferers. In these districts, power supply is so irregular that production in mills and factories has become quite uncertain recently.

Smuggled Indian medicines flood markets in border areas

JHENIDAH, Apr 18: Smuggled Indian medicines have flooded the markets of Jhenidah and adjoining districts in the last few years. As a result local pharmaceutical companies are facing problems. It is alleged.

According to sources, most of the smuggled medicines from India enter the country through different border points like, Pragpur in Kushtia district, Jibannagar and Darshana in Chuadanga district, Benapole in Jessore district and some other points.

Penadur LA (Benzathin Penicillin) injection, Oxytetracycline (30cc) injection, Imferon (2cc) injection, Diclofenac Sodium injection and tablets as well as Paracetamol tablets and syrup, are some common items that are being smuggled into the country.

Most of the products are manufactured by incorporated companies like Glaxo, Bayer and Tata.

A source said that about two and a half thousand youngmen are engaged in smuggling medicine. Most of them are unemployed and some are allegedly involved in medicine trade.

The source further said that these dishonest youngmen are also involved in selling government supplied medicines which are supplied for various, Thana Health Complexes, (THC), Health Sub Centres (HSC), Family Welfare Clinics (FWC) and Maternity and child health care (MCA) centres. These institutions are supposed to get the medicines free of cost.

The source also informed that most of the items are produced by government owned Essential Drugs Company (EDCO) Limited at Bogra and Dhaka.

Talking to one of the Managing Directors (MD) of a pharmaceutical manufacturing company, it was gathered that the dishonest people are selling the medicines at much lower price in the markets. This situation has affected both the local and multinational companies, and the government is losing crores of Taka every year.

Meanwhile, the poor patients are compelled to purchase the drugs from the private traders instead of government hospitals or clinics.

The source also informed that Jhenidah police acting on a secret information recovered some fake drugs from a chemist's shop and arrested one person who allegedly came to sell the drugs at Jhenidah a few months back.

The Superintendent of Drugs, Jessore told The Daily Star that they do not have sufficient man power and vehicles to check the malpractice.

Even though the region has registered a rise in business activities, The Drugs Authority (DA) do not have an office in every district, it was learnt.

College student stabbed to death

BOGRA, Apr 18: A college student was stabbed to death by a group of people at Bejora village in suburb area of Bogra town Monday, reports UNB.

The victim was identified as Mostafa Kamal, 18, son of Tajul Islam of Bejora village.

Bogra Kotwali thana police said Mostafa was killed at about 8-30 pm after four muggers stabbed him indiscriminately. He was declared dead by attending doctors at Bogra Mohammad Ali Hospital.

This is the fifth murder in the town in past two weeks.

One of the snatchers was caught by local people and handed him over to the police.

Young boy burnt to death in hospital

SYLHET, Apr 18: A four-year boy was burnt to death Saturday in the Sylhet MAG Osmany Medical College Hospital.

The victim, Alam, was injured seriously when his bed and mosquito net caught fire on Saturday night. He is the son of Shahjahan Miah of Balepara of Kotwali thana.

Deadlock over IU VC's resignation continues

KUSHTIA, Apr 18: Almost a month-long administrative deadlock created after the resignation of the Vice Chancellor of Islamic University in Kushtia is yet to be settled, reports UNB.

"We have not received any response till Saturday night from the Chancellor regarding the resignation submitted by Vice Chancellor Prof Dr Abdul Hamid on March 22," a member of the Islamic University Teachers' Association said.

Prof Hamid left the campus on March 20 after being harassed by the agitating students. Before his resignation he removed Dr Ashraf Ali, Dean of the Faculty of Social Science, from the post of Registrar and appointed S M Tauhid, Chief Engineer of the University as Registrar, in addition to his own duties, with effect from March 25 by a letter issued on March 15.

The students, however, got furious against the removal order of Dr Ashraf from his additional duty as Registrar, and put pressure on S M Tauhid not to function as the Registrar. Accordingly Tauhid was forced to submit his resignation as Registrar on March 27 and since then the post has been lying vacant.

K M Ashraf Hossain, Controller of Examinations, and Nazrul Islam Chowdhury, Director of Accounts have been put under suspension since long.

The Treasurer of the University Prof Lutful Rahman also left the campus on April 9 after disbursing the salaries of the last month. He also resigned from his post on March 22.

Goons raid border hamlets in CHT Residents assaulted, property looted

NAIRGKHIONGCHHARI (Bandarban), Apr 18: The frighten tribal villagers of Ghundhum and Tumru villages have been passing their days in extreme insecurity following a barbarous dacoity which was committed there recently leaving twelve persons assaulted and looting away goods worth about Taka ten lakh in a commando style, the victims alleged.

According to the victims, local leaders and union parishad sources, a gang of 20-25 bandits equipped with lethal weapons marauded the villages Ghundhum and Tumru some 75 kilometres from Naingkhionghari thana headquarters in the dead hours in the night following Friday April 17. Encircling the hamlets, the bandits created reign of terror, beat the villagers mercilessly and looted away movable properties and house-hold appliances including cash worth about ten lakh. The bandits also allegedly raped the tribal girls, critically injured Mongchai Nue, 38 of Ghundhum village said.

The bandits, allegedly from the neighbouring Rohingya camps stepped up atrocities on eighteen homesteads of Ghundhum and Tumru villages, all belonging to tribals, the victims said the eighteen houses, were ransacked including the house of Mongchai Nue Talayoung, Uchingama, Shukacharan, Mongkaiyenu, Womeyong, Kanurang, Chaing Hla, Chandra Mohang, Aung Chaila, Tanchapu and Aung Kai Mong.

The critically injured Nimaiching 24, Ucheingmar 40 and Shukacharan 35 were admitted in Ukhia Health

Complex with the help of a member of local union parishad Ali Akbar with grievous wounds, others were given first-aid, the union parishad member said.

The bandits while leaving with the looting, warned the victims that they will be killed if any steps were taken for taking shelter of law, the victims alleged.

On December 22, 1994 a man was stabbed to death in broad day light in Dumru village, the border hamlet of the country, the law and order situation of the village has deteriorated beyond any reasonable limit due to absence of any installation of law enforcing agency. An out post of police is bare necessity for the living human-being of the locality said the panicked people of the area, adding that with the influx of Rohingya refugees, the situation started worsening.

Naingkhionghari thana police said though there was no case filed with them in this connection, an investigation has started to collect getting informal information.

The panicked villagers, who have been crying for peace, sought their security from the concerned authority.

Barisal needs more fire stations to avoid rising losses of lives

BARISAL, Apr 18: Fire incidents are on rise, destroying property worth crores of taka every year in nine thanas of the district due to lack of adequate fire service units and better communication system, reports UNB.

According to official sources, property worth taka several crores was gutted in the thanas last year due to inadequate number of fire service stations.

There are no fire service units in the district except one in the district headquarters. A modern fire station has been set up in Patuakhali district.

Besides, due to absence of good communication in Mehenidiganj, Hizla and Muladi thanas, the firemen cannot reach the spot in time. Riverine communication is only link between the district and thana headquarters and the people of the area become helpless during the dry season.

According to District Fire Service and Civil Defence office, plans have been taken to set up fire service units at Gournadi, Banaripara, Mathbaria and Bhandaria under Barisal Fire Service Zone.

Meanwhile, eight people were injured and property worth Taka several lakhs was burnt to ashes in a devastation fire that broke out at Dhamura bazar in Uzirpur thana in the first week of this month. During the fire incident, the people of the area were helpless in the absence of fire service unit nearby.

Moulvibazar top list in fire incidents

MOULVIBAZAR, April 18: A total of 69 fire incidents occurred in Moulvibazar and Horigonj districts in March and the losses were estimated at about Tk 32 crore.

The Fire Service and Civil Defence Department source told The Daily Star that two persons including a woman were burnt alive, and a considerable number of animals and birds were roasted.

The origins of fire incidents recorded were furnace, electric short circuits and burning cigarettes.

The fire destroyed property which included five tea gardens, 170 shops at Madhabpur thana headquarters and shops and dwelling houses at different rural areas of the two districts.

Nor'wester hits Sirajganj: 7 hurt

SIRAJGANJ, Apr 18: Seven people including a couple were seriously injured in a nor'wester that lashed six unions in two thanas of the district early today, reports UNB.

The couple Abdur Rahim, 45, and Sofia Khatun of Kouzuri union in Shahzadpur thana were seriously injured when their tin-shed house fell on them. Later they were admitted in Kouzuri Health Clinic.

Shahzadpur and Chouhali Thana Nirbahi officers said the storm hit the unions of Jalalpur, Khukni, Kouzuri and Porjona in Shahzadpur while Mirkutia union in Chouhali.

Some 150 kutcha houses were also razed to the ground in the area and large number of trees were uprooted during the onslaught which continued for nearly half an hour.
