Iran, India sign MOU for oil exploration

NEW DELHI, Apr 19: India's Oil and Natural Gas Corp (ONGC) and the national Iran Oil Co will launch a joint venture company for exploration and production of oil and natural gas, India's petroleum ministry said vesterday, reports

Reuter. H said Indian Petroleum Minister Satish Sharma and his Iranian counterpart Gholam Raza Aghazadeh signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) after two rounds of bilateral talks in New Delhi.

Aghazadeh was accompanying Iranian President Alt Akbar Hashemi Rafsanjani on a threeday visit to India. ~

The new joint venture company linking the two statecontrolled groups would explore and produce oil and gas in Iran, India and third countries, an Indian statement said without disclosing financial details.

The two sides also reviewed progress on their ambitious five billion dollar Iran-India gas pipeline.

foreign currencies effective on April 19.

The gas authority of India Ltd and the national Iran Oil Co decided to complete the feasibility study on the project and to invite global oil companies to participate in it, the statement said.

India signed an agreement with Iran in 1993 to build a 2,200-kilometre (1,400 miles) gas pipeline and they have been looking at several options for building it.

The pipeline, which would supply 50 million cubic metres of gas to India year, is expected to be commissioned by the turn of the century.

India wants to build an underwater pipeline through the Arabian sea, but Iran prefers a line passing through Pakistan. India's arch-foe since the two countries gained independence from Britain in 1947.

Rafsanjani said in the northern Indian city of Lucknow on Tuesday there was need for closer cooperation between South Asian countries and Iran.




