Jointly sponsored by the Department of Forest and the United States Fish and Wildlife Service the objective of this workshop is to apprise the participants of the rules, procedures and technical aspects of CITES for its proper implementation in Bangladesh.

Twenty-six field officers from customs, police, Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) and NGOs are taking part in the work-

Inaugurated by additional secretary in-charge of the Ministry of Environment and For-

est Sved Amir ul-Mulk the in augural session was also ad dressed by deputy conservator of forest Syed Salamat Ali. conservators of forest M A Sattar and A H M Monzurul Karim and representative of US Fish and Wildlife Service John Brooks. Chief Conservator of Forest (CCF) Dr Shamsur Rahman presided.




