VILNIUS. Apr 25: Italy striker Roberto Baggio has slight fever and may not play in Wednesday's European Championship qualifier in Lithuania. reports Reuter.

#### IABF to skip it

NEW DELHI, Apr 25: The Indian Amateur Boxing Federation (IABF) has decided to skip the World Championship in order to concentrate fully on the next SAF Games and the Asian Boxing Championship, reports PTI.

The South Asian Federation (SAF) Games are scheduled to be held in Madras later this year while the Asian Championship is scheduled from September 30 to October eight in Tashkent.

IABF secretary Ashok Gangopadhyay told PTI here Monday that the federation wanted to focus mainly on the SAF Games and the Asian Championship and hence has decided not to send Indian team to Berlin where the championship would be held from May 5 to 15. "There is no point in send-

ing a small team for the World Championship. Instead. we thought it is better to concentrate on the SAF Games and the Asian championship," Gangopadhyay said.
