Probe into Sylhet incident demanded

Several leading members of various professions Wednesday urged the government to immediately conduct a judicial enquiry into the 'Sylhet incident' for ensuring the rule of law and basic human rights.

At a meeting in the city yesterday, the speakers deplored the rising fundamentalism and communalism in the country. They also felt that if the government failed to probe the incident, a private enquiry should be conducted immediately.

The meeting, organised by leading intellectuals at the initiative of elderly poet Begum Sulfa Kamal, was held at the Professional Business Women's Club. It was presided over by former Vice Chancellor Khan Sarwar Murshid.

The speakers observed that organisers of the reception committee set up to welcome Poet Shamsur Rahman in Sylhet were attacked by the fundamentalist forces. Even animals of a circus party in Cox's Bazar also fell victim to these anti-liberation forces, they said.

The meeting resolved to mobilise collective efforts and create public opinion through holding convention of socio-cultural parties. It also called for holding of rallies and demonstrations by the women community, journalists, teachers and writers.

Justice K M Sobhan, Faiz Ahmed, Dr Kamal Hussain, Mujahidul Islam Selim, Nasiruddin Yusuf Bacchu, Prof B K Jhangir, Azfar Hossain, Shirin Akhter, Kamal Pasha Chowdhury, Golam Kuddus, Towhid Reza Noor and Rakhi Das Purokaiostha also spoke at the meeting. Dr Ali Reaz read out the resolutions.

The Nazrul Institute has taken a programme to publish new and cheaper editions of some famous books of national poet Kazi Nazrul Islam.

The books will be published with special grant of the Ministry of Cultural Affairs on the occasion of the anniversary of birth of the poet on May 25, says a press release of the Institute.

The books which will be published include Agnibina, Bisher Banshi, Sarbahara, Dulanchanpa, Bangargan, Nazruler Chutta Galpa, Nazruler Shishutosh Kavita and Nazrul Sangeeter Talika.
