Early warning system for stock markets recommended

An early warning system and watch dog vigilance over the stock markets are the most important things to protect the stock markets from shocks.

This was said, in a number of recommendations made by the recently concluded 10th South Asian Federation Accountants (SAFA) conference.

The recommendations of the conference were disclosed yesterday at a press briefing at a local hotel.

Briefing the journalists about the outcome of the conference the current SAFA President Jamal Uddin Ahmad said, as many as 27 recommendations have been emerged from the technical papers, commentaries and floor discussions at the conference on "Capital Market Development in the SAARC Region."

The two-day conference was held on 21-22 March last in Dhaka. President Abdur Rahman Biswas inaugurated the conference and over 450 delegates from SAARC countries attended.


