Exposing War Criminals of '71

It was a flashback into the horrors of the Liberation War. specifically of the atrocities committed by the Pakistani occupation Army and their collaborators, when a film, titled, The War Crimes File by Twenty-Twenty television, was shown to a select audience at the Goethe Cultural Institut in Dhaka yesterday.

The film, broadcast on May 3rd on Channel 4 in a series called "Dispatches," is about three alleged war criminals and collaborators-Chowdhury Muenuddin, Abu Sayed and Lutfar Rahman - who are now British nationals living in the UK for over 20 years. Tracing

back to the home towns in Bangladesh of all three men. documents eye-witness accounts of the wartime atrocities allegedly committed by

The documentary was a result of nine months of research in Bangladesh and Britain.

Chowdhury Muenuddin, now president of a Jamaat-e-Islami wing in Britain and vice chairman of an East London mosque, has been accused of being the operation-in-charge of the intellectual killings of Dhaka City as one of the leaders of the notorious Al Badr forces, a para-military death squad of the Pakistani Army.

 Abu Sayeed, another leader of the Jamaat-e-Islami and one-time Imam of East London, is also an alleged war criminal from Sylhet.

Lutfur Rahman, now an Imam in a mosque, in Birmingham, has been accused of making hit lists for the Al-Badr forces.

All three were allegedly responsible for the systematic torture and killing of intellectuals and rapes and abduction of countless women in 1971.

The film intends not only to expose these men for their alleged crimes but also help to try them in Britain.

British law states that war criminals, no matter what their nationality, if found guilty of war crimes, could be tried in Britain. The members of Projanmo Ekattur hope that the three men will be tried and punished, even if it is in Britain, since little has been done in Bangladesh to try the collaborators of '71 who have been protected by successive

governments. Eye-witnesses interviewed in the film included relatives of the intellectuals who were killed, journalists who worked for the Liberation, former Muktibahini members, a survivor of a death camp, colleagues and associates of the three men and two anonymous former Al-Badr cadres.

Compelling and moving, the documentary showed some rare footage of the Liberation War - muktijodhya's fighting. rape victims being given aid and Hindu students being herded and shot by Pakistani soldiers. Scenes of the bodies of dead intellectuals in Rayer Bazar were also shown.

The film was produced by Gita Sahgal with Claudia Milne as Executive Producer, Howard Bradburn as Director and David Bradburn as Reporter.


