CHITTAGONG, May 13: Muhammad Belal, chief reporter of the daily Purbokone, died of jaundice and asthma at the PG Hospital in Dhaka this morning, his family sources said. He was 42, reports BSS.

He left behind his wife, two sons and one daughter and a host of relatives and friends to mourn his death.

His body will be flown to Chittagong this evening. It will be kept at Chittagong Press Club and then the at dainik Purbokone office for some time tomorrow morning.

The mortal remains of Muhammad Belal will be buried at Shahgarib Ullah graveyard in the city.

Belal started his journalism career as sub-editor of Banglar Bani. He also worked with the daily Life, daily Sangbad and now defunct dainik Zamana. He also worked as stringer of Reuter and radio Australia here. He joined dainik Purbokone as chief reporter in 1986.

Biswas meets Birendra

President Abdur Rahman Biswas had an hour-long meeting with King Birendra of Nepal in London Friday and discussed matters of mutual interest, bilateral and regional issues, according to a message received in Dhaka yesterday, reports BSS.

They also discussed the existing friendly and good neighbourly relations between the two countries and expansion of trade and other ties.

The King recalled the recent visit of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia to Nepal and observed that the visit has further contributed to cementing the relation between the two countries.

The President expressed the hope that relations between the two countries would strengthen in the coming days.

The King and the President also discussed the issue of harnessing water resources in the region. During the discussion, Farakka and other water issues also came up. The President explained difficulties that Bangladesh have been facing due to unilateral withdrawal of water of the river Ganges at Farakka and other common rivers.

High Commissioner of Bangladesh in the UK Dr A F M Yusuf was present during the meeting which took place at Grosvenor Hotel at King's suite where President Biswas was also staying.

Later, President Biswas visited Folkestone and offered his Jumma prayers at the South East Kent Islamic Cultural Centre along with a large number of Bangladeshi Muslims.

Local leaders of BNP and Bangladeshi community also joined the prayers with the President.

The President also attended a luncheon reception hosted in his honour by the Kent BNP.

Later on, Michael Howard,

Home Secretary of Britain called on the President at a local hotel and exchanged greetings with him.

He also welcomed the President in Folkestone from where Howard represents in the parliament.

President also visited the Euro Tunnel exhibition centre at Folkestone and went round the centre.

He later visited WYE Agricultural College of London University and met the Bangladeshi students, teachers of the college there.

John Prescott, the principal of the college, took him round the college, including research centre, laboratory and horticultural garden.

Another report adds: President Biswas who is on an official visit to the Great Britain offered his Eid prayers at the Regent Park Islamic Centre, the biggest mosque in the United Kingdom, along with hundreds of Muslims from different parts of the world.

Ambassadors and High Commissioners of the Muslim countries and officials of the embassies and a large number of Bangladeshis joined the prayers at the Islamic Centre.

On arrival, the President was received by the acting director of the centre.

In the evening, President Biswas attended an Eid reception at the residence of Bangladesh High Commissioner and exchanged greetings with the officials and their family members.
