

POTATO FRENCH FRY

Ingredients and Quantity table for Potato French Fry recipe.



Method of Preparation

- Peel and cut raw potatoes into 1/4 inch (6mm) thick strips. Put the potato strips in cold water to keep them crisp and white. Drain and dry well. Heat about 4 inches (10 cm) of vegetable oil to a shallow/deep-fat fryer or heavy saucepan to the frying temperature 375°F. Fry potato slices for 5-7 minutes stirring with the straining spoon until golden brown and crisp. Slow heat is good for french fry. Remove with the straining spoon, dry well on paper towels, salt lightly and sprinkle with hot chillies powder/black pepper and serve hot. The french fries may be prepared before and kept in the refrigerator and refried when needed.

Preserve relics to uphold nat'l heritage: Khaleda

PAHARPUR, Naogaon, May 16: Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia today underlined the importance of preserving architectural and archaeological relics to uphold national heritage, history and tradition, reports UNB.

"A nation can earn worldwide acclaim through display of relics from the history, heritage and civilisation," she said while inaugurating the Paharpur Museum in Naogaon district.

The Paharpur Buddhist monastery built in the 8th century during the rule of Buddhist kings in Bangladesh and the historic 60-domed mosque built at Bagerhat in the 15th century have been included in the World heritage list.

Begum Zia said, "Our archaeological identity needs to be depicted more to the outside world for further building our image. If we succeed in this endeavour, our tourism industry will also flourish."

The Prime Minister said Bangladesh is a land of ancient civilisation and cultural heritage. "We have a history of two thousand and five hundred years of urban civilisation."

She mentioned the distinct characteristics of the nation and cited Paharpur as an example of glorious heritage and civilisation.

Protesters burn Indian flag

Jatiya Ganatantrik Party (JAGPA) yesterday burnt the Indian flag and an effigy of Prime Minister Narasimha Rao during a demonstration protesting the demolition of a Muslim shrine in India, reports UNB.

The demonstrators also demanded the just share of the water of the Ganges for Bangladesh.

The JAGPA activists burnt the Indian flag and Rao's effigy after police halted their procession near the Science Laboratory crossing at about 5:00 pm, witnesses said. They were chanting anti-Indian slogans.

Riot police halted the JAGPA activists near Science Laboratory crossing while they tried to proceed towards the Indian High Commission at Dhanmandi.

Workshop on TB, leprosy held 2 electrocuted in city

Health and Family Welfare Minister Chowdhury Kamal Hossain yesterday said the government is fully committed to develop healthcare facilities for the masses and attain the target of health for all within the stipulated period, reports BSS.

He was speaking as chief guest at the inaugural session of a day-long workshop on "Orientation course on tuberculosis (TB) and leprosy control programme" in Bangladesh, a Tk 109-crore project under the Health Ministry.

Held at the auditorium of the National Institute for Social and Preventive Medicine (NIPSON), the session was presided over by Director of Micro-Bacterial Diseases Control Dr A K Md Ahsan Ali. Director General of Health Services Prof A K Shamsuddin Siddiqui among others spoke on the occasion.

Hossain said that TB and leprosy had been identified as major public health problem in Bangladesh. Terming the TB and leprosy control project as one of the biggest programmes in the health sector, the minister said that its service has already reached the common people through primary health care package.

Attack on Lekhak Shibir office condemned

Acting convener of the Ekatturer Ghatik Dalai Nirmul Committee Shahrir Kabir in a statement last night condemned the attack on the office of Bangladesh Lekhak Shibir and Bangladesh Chhatra Federation at Purana Paltan in the city yesterday, said a press release.

The statement alleged the attack was part of the anti-liberation Jamaat-Shibir clique's continuous assaults on the pro-liberation and progressive forces.

By DMCH Correspondent Two persons were electrocuted while two others were stabbed in separate incidents in the city yesterday. Rajjan, 20, and Azhar, 32, were electrocuted when they were erecting a bamboo bridge at Shahidnagar in Lalbagh area yesterday afternoon.

Meanwhile, muggers stabbed a cloth trader Salahuddin, 22, of Aradhaz, Narayanganj, near the fruit market at Gullistan in the city at around 6:00 pm yesterday.

Sources said that the muggers also snatched Tk 17,000 from Salahuddin.

He was admitted to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

In another incident, a group of extortionists seriously stabbed a tailor Shahidul Islam, 18, at Payarabagh in Maghbazar yesterday afternoon.

The unidentified group armed with sharp instruments stabbed Shahidul as he refused to give them demand money. He was admitted to the DMCH.
