Nirmul to gear up activities

The Ghatak Dalal Nirmul Committee is preparing to reactivate its movement against the anti-liberation forces that has slowed down after the death of Jahanara Imam on June 26 last year, reports

"We are taking preparations to gear up our activities demanding trial of the war criminals", said Nirmul Committee leader Shahriar Kabir while exchanging views with newsmen at the committee's Mahakhali office yesterday.

He said that at the first phase of their renewed movement, the committee would set up reading centres at the ward level in Dhaka city to let the young generation know about the Liberation War.

The Committee members have also launched a programme to collect the names of people who sacrificed their lives during the Liberation War in 1971, Kabir informed.

"This is really a tragedy that after long 25 years of independence, we do not have a complete list of the martyrs," said the acting Convenor of the Nirmul Committee. "We want to complete it."

He said the Committee would publish a monthly bulletin. "Jagoron", in Bangla and a quarterly in English.

About the Nirmul Committee's next programmes, Kabir said they would organise a march towards Parliament and also submit a memorandum to the Prime Minister on June 29 demanding fulfillment of its four-point demand, including the trial of Ghulam Azam before a special tribunal for his war crimes.

Rickshaw - a necessary evil By Krishna P Roy

Though experts consider the increased number of unlicensed rickshaws in the city to be a major obstacle to a sound traffic system, these threewheeled contraptions still remain the most popular mode of transportation here.

The Dhaka Integrated Transport Study (DITS) says that although the bus has emerged as the cheapest mode of transportation in the city, rickshaws are still popular among city people.

The largest number of rickshaw-riders are from both the upper-middle group and the middle income group. However; most of the labour employed in this industry is from the low income group, the study says.

The DC (Traffic) Mustag Hossain Khan was of the opinion that rickshaws could not be removed once and for all, since these vehicles have de-

But there must be a system, he said, and the number of rickshaws should be brought within a reasonable figure.

The DITS says even though travel by rickshaw costs more than by bus, people who do not have access to private cars are willing to pay the extra amount for the door-to-door service offered by this mode of trans-

The strong preference for


this form of service presents a major policy dilemma to the authority providing transportation services to the Dhaka city dwellers, the study says.

There is ample evidence that bus services can be expanded and offered at substantially lower rates than those offered by the rickshaw, but comfort considerations are likely to be more important than fares alone.

A survey shows that there is a strong preference for rickshaw travel by the women of the city to avoid the harass ment often faced in crowded buses. Women from higher income households are required to avail rickshaw transportation when they do not get the luxury of travelling by cars. Women from low income groups often tend to walk as that remains their only practical option.

Many educated women, employed in private enterprises and government departments, are provided with privately organised means of transport by their employers. particularly when distances are too far to be commutable by rickshaws.

The DITS suggests that an effective mass-transit system and a high quality bus service will be required to divert travellers from their preferred mode of transportation - the ever-increasing rickshaw.


