Prior to the handing over of the memorandum, members of the Projonmo will assemble in front of the Jatiya Press Club at 10 am tomorrow, says a press release.

Recently, Channel 4, a television network in Britain, telecast a documentary titled 'The War Crimes File' which depicted atrocities by these three war criminals, namely Chaudhury Muftuiddin, Abu Sayeed and Lofur Rahman, during the country's fight for freedom.
