BCL demands resumption of IU classes

Pro Awami League Chhatra League (BCL) Islamic University (IU) unit, demanded resumption of classes and protested the alleged terrorist activities by the Islami Chhatra Shibir.

The BCL, at a press conference yesterday at the Madhu's Canteen of the Dhaka University, also urged the authorities to withdraw the expulsion order against its three leaders of the university unit, including its president Afsar Ali.

The university was closed since die on April 29 following the killing on the campus of a pourashava commissioner of Kumerkhali in Kushtia.

The university authorities, since then, also put a ban on all kind of political activities on the campus.

The BCL leaders said they will submit a memorandum to the vice chancellor on June 1, exchange views with politicians and professionals from June 2-7 and hold a rally on the campus on June 16 to press home their demands.

The press conference was addressed by BCL leaders, including Abu Syed Al Masud, Dipok Bhoomik, Abdul Wadud Khakoni, Afsar Ali and Mir Zilur Rahman.
