High prices of spares worry bus owners

NARAYANGANJ, June 4: Bus and minibus owners here urged the government to bring down the prices of motor spare parts, tyres and tubes which have gone up more than two fold in the recent months.

"If the government does not respond to our call, we may have to go on transport strikes on the Dhaka-Narayanganj route," said the convener of the bus-minibus owners' associations' liaison committee Ali Ahmed at a press conference in the port town.

In the recent months, the price of a bus wheel has gone up to Tk 12,000 from Tk 6,000, while a Tk 2,000 engine head now costs Tk 10,000. A gear box worth Tk 10,000 now sells at Tk 25,000, a 2,000 taka. pressure plate at 4,000 taka, a Tk 40,000 minibus engine at Tk 75,000 and a Tk 2,000 minibus's gear box at Tk 10,000.

"We believe, a group of unscrupulous traders in league with some government officials are responsible for this price hike, and an artificial crisis of motor vehicle accessories has already been created. All Ahmed said.

The press conference held in the town was also addressed by secretaries of Dhaka Narayanganj Bus Minibus Malik Samity, Dhaka Narayanganj Zila Sarak Paribahan Samity, Narayanganj Zila Bus Owners' Group, Adhunik Bus Minibus Malik Samity and Antazla Bus Minibus Malik Samity.

They said that many transport owners have started selling their vehicles as a result of the price hike, while one-third of the buses and minibuses were off the roads for repairs which the owners could not afford.

There are some 475 buses and minibuses plying in the Dhaka-Narayanganj route.

Replying to a question, the owners said that they have no intention of increasing bus fares further, but to fight to reduce the prices of the accessories within their reach.

Hamdard chief due today
President of Hamdard Foundation of Pakistan and Chancellor of Madinatul Hikmat (Hamdard University) Hakim Mohammed Said arrives in the city today on a four-day visit to Bangladesh, reports BSS.

Chief of Army Staff Lieutenant General Abu Saleh Mohammad Nasim, Bir Bikram left Dhaka for a goodwill visit to China. He is leading a seven member military delegation, said an ISPR press release, reports BSS.

During the visit, Nasim will call on the Chinese Defence Minister General Chi Haotian. He will also exchange views with chief of the General Staff of the People's Liberation Army (PLA) General Zhang Wannian and other senior military officials.

His programme also includes the laying of wreaths the monument of the People's Heroes and the mausoleum of chairman Mao Cedong in Beijing, as well as visits to an infantry division of the PLA, the National Defence University and military installations and establishment in Shanghai. He is scheduled to return on June 12.
