Index continues to leap

The Dhaka Stock Exchange All Share Price Index continued to leap on an improved trading on the floor Sunday.

The price index rose by 5.36 points, or 0.75 per cent, increasing to 723.1876 from Saturday's 717.82222.

The transactions in volume increased by 8.36 per cent and the transactions in value showed a rise of 13.08 per cent.

A total of 135372 shares worth Taka 22080727.70 changed hands as against 123261 shares valued at Taka 19525456.50.

Total market capital reached Taka 42.87 billion from Taka 42.55 billion.

The number of issues traded rose to 86 from Taka 78, in which 51 gained, 25 incurred losses and the share prices of 10 issues remained unchanged.

Singer Bangladesh enjoyed a gain of Taka 185.51 per share, leading the gainers in terms of value. IDLC, Beximco Fisheries (Debt) and Beximco Knitting (Debt) also posted significant increases in their share prices.

On the other hand, Azis Pipes led the losers with a fall of Taka 13.06 per share. Eastern Housing was the top volume leader, with 26980 shares traded.

Other volume leaders of the day were: Ashraf Textile (14950), BOC Bangladesh (10686), Apex Weaving (9208), Shine Pakur Holdings (9208), Dynamic Textile (6980), Beximco Ltd (6500) and Confidence Cement (5660).

Iraq's invasion of Kuwait inflicts \$ 700b loss on Arab countries

MUSCAT, June 4: Iraq's invasion of Kuwait in 1990 inflicted a loss of around 700 billion dollars on Arab states, nearly double their oil earnings in five years, according to an Arab official, reports AFP.

The Iraqi invasion of Kuwait has crippled the Arab system as it sapped around 700 billion dollars, which his nearly double the total Arab oil income since 1985 and 1990...

Hamad did not give a breakdown for the losses. But previous Arab reports spoke about direct and indirect loss, including damage to oil and other facilities in the Iraq and Kuwait, suspension of remittances from the two countries and higher Arab oil import bills due to a surge in crude prices.
