7 killed in separate incidents

Seven people were killed and two others injured in separate incidents in and around the city Tuesday.

One Abdul Hannan, 50, who came to Dhaka from Saudi Arabia early in the morning was seriously injured in a road accident at Gulistan at about 9:30 am. He succumbed to his injuries at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH).
A minibus hit him when he was crossing the road.
An unknown male aged about 50 was killed on the spot when a speeding truck ran over him at Jatrabari.

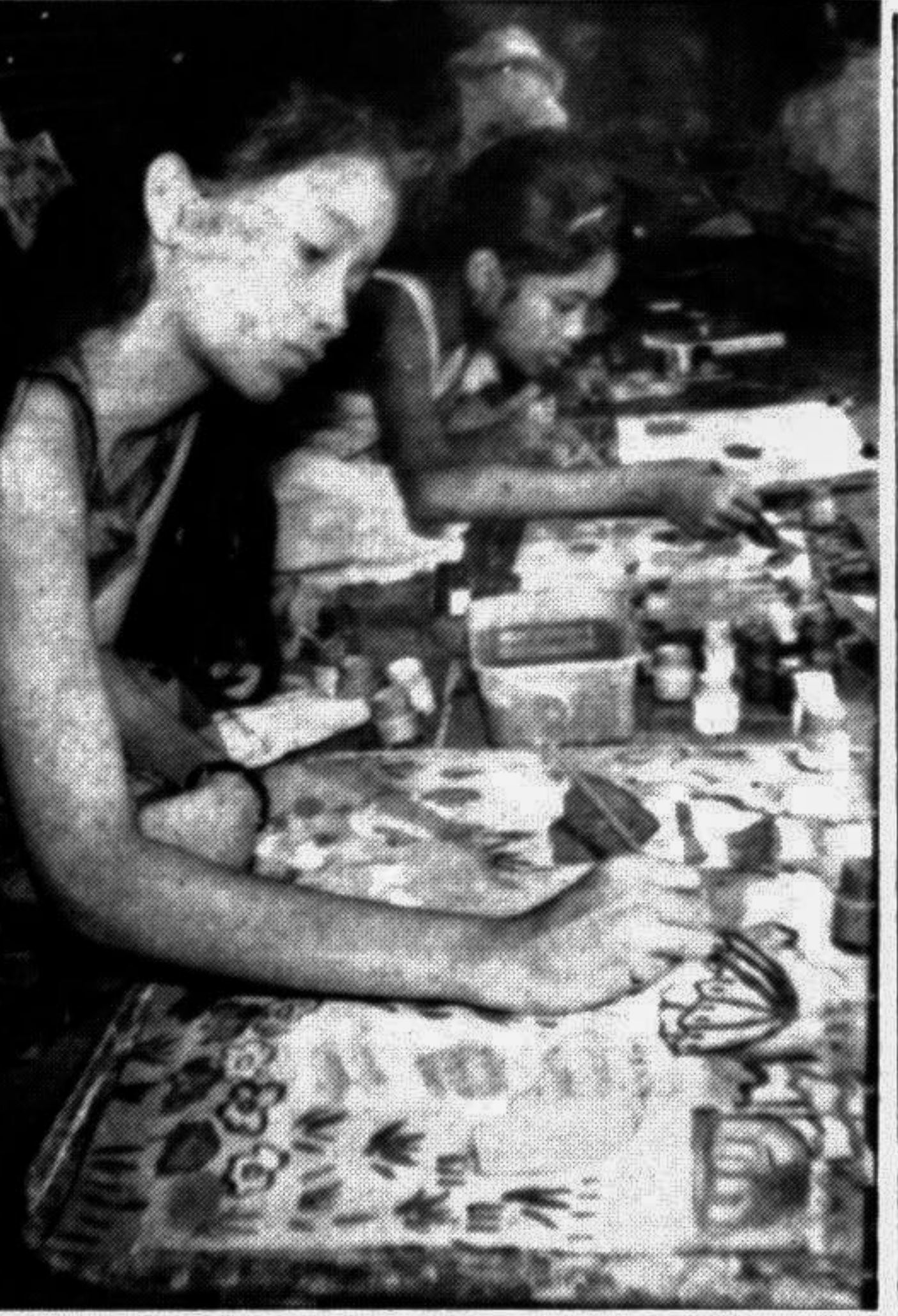
Saidur Rahman, 32, who received serious injuries in a road accident at Bijoy Sarani Tuesday afternoon, died at the DMCH yesterday morning.
Hira, 25, who was with Saidur, was also injured when a truck hit the motor bike they were riding. Hira is under treatment at the Orthopedic Hospital.
Meanwhile, one Amena, 45, who was wounded when a truck hit her near Malibagh Bazar late Tuesday, succumbed to her injuries at the DMCH yesterday. Her son, Shamsu, 7, was also injured in the accident.
One Abdul Malek, 30, a rickshawpuller, was killed when a truck knocked him down at the Syedabad bus stand.

Besides, Emon, 6, who fell from the first floor of a building at the AGB colony in Motijheel, died at the DMCH yesterday morning.
Alam, 48, reportedly committed suicide by taking poison at his residence at Savar yesterday.

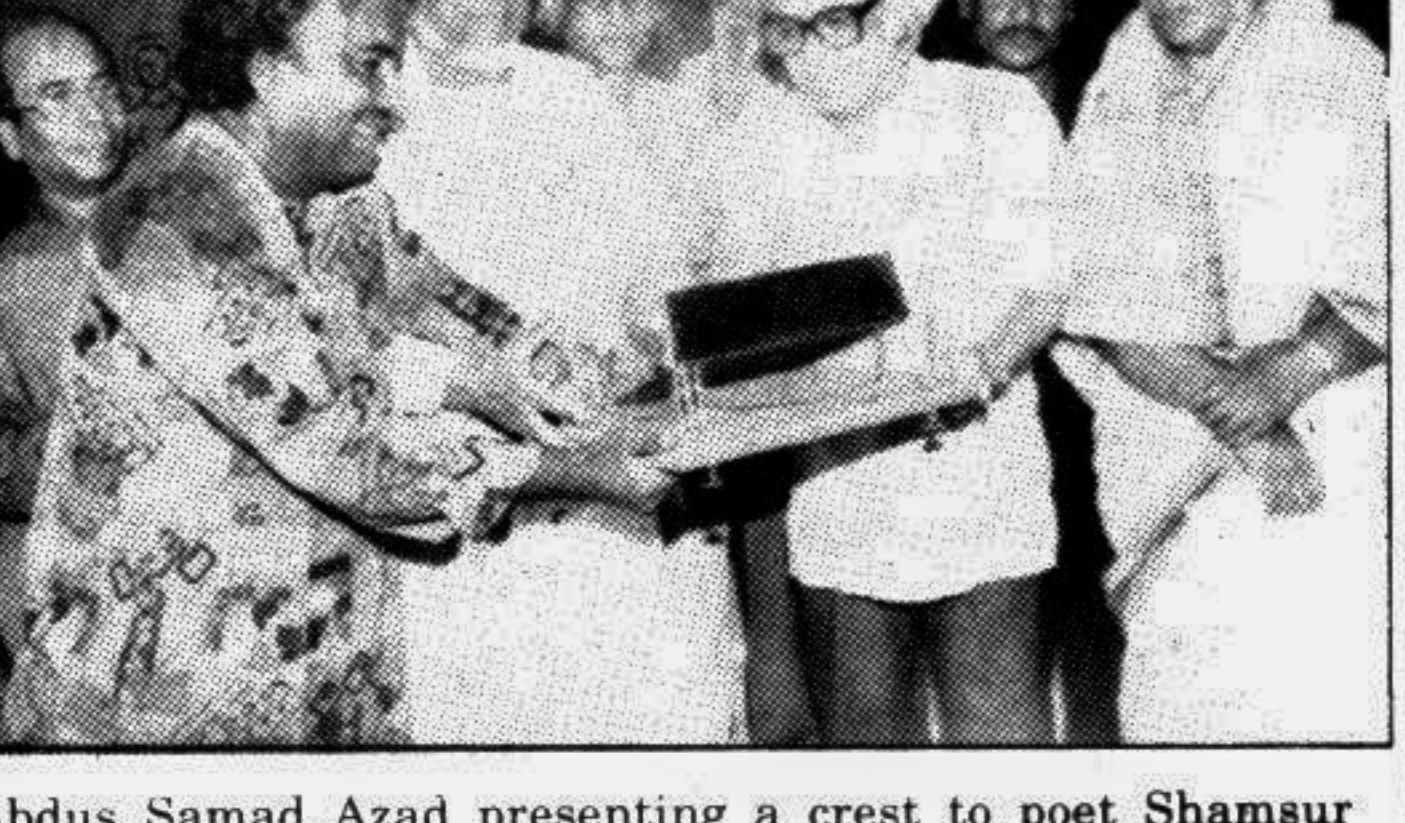

Indo-Bangla border talks likely June 26

CHITTAGONG, June 8: Bangladesh and India are scheduled to hold border talks at a high level tentatively on June 26, according to sources concerned.
The director generals of the Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) and the Border Security Force (BSF) of India are expected to lead their respective delegations at the talks to be held in Delhi, sources said.
The recent border trouble in Asalong sector in Khagrachhari district and other important issues will figure at the talks.
The DG of BDR already visited Asalong border area on June 6. The trouble along the 13 Km long Asalong border followed the deployment of BSF personnel and digging of trenches along the border line in Tripura after a clash between two groups of farmers from India and Bangladesh over farming in the disputed Fenichhara river catchment.
A status quo is now being maintained in the disputed area after India pulled back some 200 border guards in line with the decision reached at the May 25 flag-meeting

UNESCO official meets Sircar
