Muslim League team meets CEC

A delegation of the Bangladesh Muslim League (ML) led by its executive president S M Amjad Hussain yesterday exchanged views with the Election Commission on the process of voters registration, and the ways and means of holding free and fair elections, reports BSS.

The Muslim League delegation requested the Commission to take steps necessary to prevent fake registration of voters and also for enrolling the expatriate Bangladeshis through the country's missions abroad.

The delegation demanded the freeing of the electoral process from extortion and keeping the general administration and security forces under the command of the Election Commission during the election. It also urged the Commission to declare ineligible the defaulters of loans for contesting the elections, and make arrangements for the quick disposal of election cases.

The Chief Election Commissioner Justice A K M Sadek, who listened to the suggestions, assured the ML delegation that he would consider their proposals carefully and sought their cooperation for holding free and fair elections in the country.

IIT publications presented to President

Dr Abdul Matin Patwari, Director General of the Islamic Institute of Technology (Formerly ICTVTR) called on President Abdur Rahman Biswas at Bangabhaban yesterday and presented him some books and publications of the institute, reports UNB.

The director general stayed with the President for some time and explained the academic activities of the institute, said an official handout.

Talking to him, President Biswas said this is the age of technology and no nation can prosper without technical know-how.

The President was informed that some 200 students from different Muslim countries are studying in this institute besides students from Bangladesh, including teachers of different polytechnic institutes.

He expressed his satisfaction to learn that the students passing out with technical degrees from the institute are readily provided with jobs in their respective countries and are well-placed in life.

Weather

Rainfall likely

Moderate or moderately heavy rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty or squally wind is likely at a number of places over Barisal and Chittagong divisions during the 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

The Met Office says light to moderate rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty wind may occur at a few places over Khulna and Dhaka divisions and at one or two places over Rajshahi division.

South or south-easterly squall at a speed of 60-80 kilometres per hour may occur over the regions of Chittagong, Cox's Bazar, Noakhali and Patuakhali during the period.

Day temperatures are likely to fall by 1-2 degrees Celsius over Chittagong and Barisal divisions and remain nearly unchanged elsewhere across the country.

The country's highest temperature yesterday was 36.6 degrees Celsius recorded at Dhaka, Sylhet and Tangail, while the lowest was 25.0 degrees at Teknaf and Comilla.

The sun sets today at 6:46 pm and rises tomorrow at 5:10 am.
