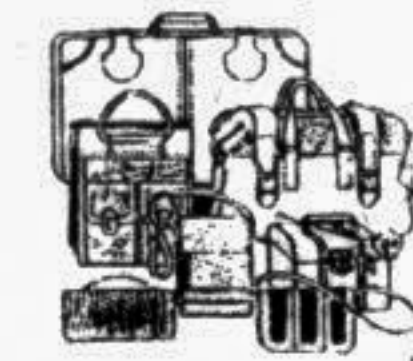
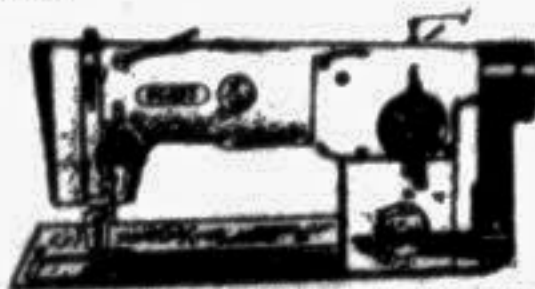

Reaction to nat'l budget

Mass unconcerned

Mixed reaction from the country's business community on the national budget for the 1995-96 fiscal is highlighted in every national daily. Some hailed the budget while others criticised it.

But the commonmen — the men of the street — farmers, day labourers, vendors, small shopkeepers, and the country's marginalised mass who comprise 80 per cent of the population — for most of them the budget is a word still to find a place in their vocabulary. On many, the budget of the Jatiya Rajasha did not have the slightest impact.

A random survey carried out by The Daily Star in the city yesterday reveals the fact that most of the people mentioned above do not have the slightest notion of what the budget could be, and many were not at all concerned about the well-publicised national event.

Here are some replies to our question "What do you think about the budget or Jatiya Rajasha?"

"What is it? Something to do with the abolition of rickshaws from the city?" Asked Shamsu Mian, a rickshaw-puller.

"All family members and I are Awami Leaguers; the people who made the Rajasha are our enemies. I have nothing to do with it." Solaiman, an ice-cream vendor reacted.

Simply tell me if the prices go up or down, requested Zohra, a housewife-cum-day

labourer.

"Who knows what you are talking about; my concern is to earn some rice for my family," Chunnu Mian, a day labourer of the New Market area, lamented.

"What did Saifur Rahman say? Will the price of rice decrease?" That was Mobinullah, a trader at Mohammadpur market.

"I will ask Mannan Bhai, our basti chief about it," stated Nuru, a rickshaw-van driver.

"Baba, why do you ask me about the Rajasha? Has it ever helped us?" Zaron Molla, a farmer from Mymensingh who came to Dhaka to seek employment, questioned.

Nirmul's planned PM's office siege today

T&T systems to be computerised

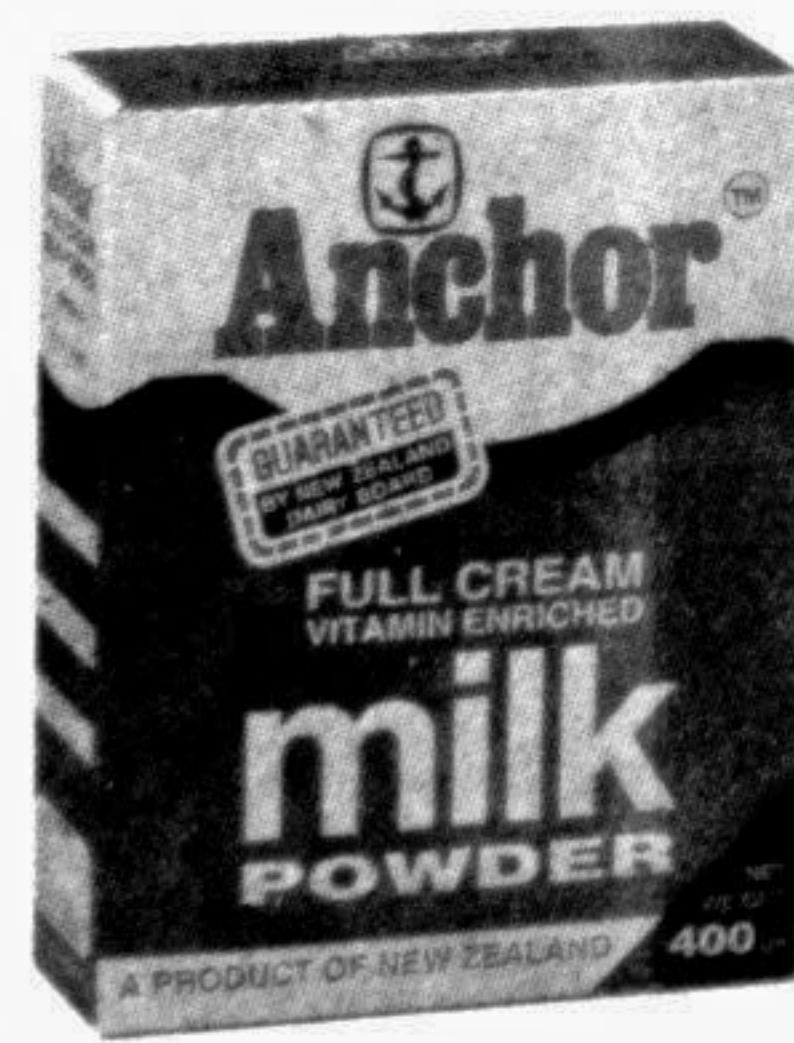
