A 37-member cultural troupe led by State Minister for Cultural Affairs Jahan Ara Begum left the city yesterday for Moscow to attend the week-long Bangladesh festival of culture, commerce and tourism beginning there on June 21, reports BSS.

The troupe will also join the second Asia-Pacific music festival at the Krasno-Yarks

The troupe will perform a number of shows in Moscow and Krasno-Yarks. As part of the Bangladesh festival, a painting and book exhibition will also be held in the Russian capital.

80 fake DU students to face expulsion

Admissions of 80 masters degree students of Dhaka University will be cancelled for submitting fake documents, reports UNB.

Official sources said 80 students were admitted to the First Part Preliminary of Marketing, Management, Accounting, Political Science, History, Islamic History, Library Science, Islamic Studies, International Relations and Sociology departments of the university in 1994 producing fake documents.

The fraud was detected when the names of the students were not found in the merit list during the cross-check, officials said preferring anonymity.

Meanwhile, the authorities has served show-cause notices against the students, attached to F Rahman and Rokeya halls, asking to submit their necessary documents by

Wednesday. The authorities may seek help of the Bureau of Anti-

corruption for legal action.


