### 472600 provided food under VGD programme

About 4,72,600 destitute women and children have been provided food assistance under Vulnerable Group Development (VGD) programme in the country during the current financial year, reports UNB.

This was disclosed at a meeting of the central coordination committee of VGD at the conference room of the Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief in the city yesterday.

Chairman of the committee State Minister for Disaster Management and Relief Harun-Al-Rashid presided.

The meeting also reviewed the progress of implementation of the programme.

The World Food Programme (WFP), Australia, Belgium, Canada, European Union, Germany and the government provided wheat to support the programme to improve the socio-economic condition of the distressed women and children.

Out of 1,65,859 metric tons of wheat, the government had provided 39,579 metric tons under this programme for the current financial year.

The beneficiaries are the destitute women and children of 4,402 unions, 56 wards of Chittagong and Khulna City Corporations, Women Training Centre, group leaders, extension workers and institutional feeding development projects.

The implementing agencies of the programme are Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief, Women and Children Affairs Ministry, and Social Welfare Ministry.

Under the programme, a destitute woman gets monthly 31.25 kgs of wheat for a period of two years.

Disaster Management and Relief Secretary IU Malik, Representative of World Food Programme, Rome Giorgio Maragallino, Country Director Alan Wilkinson, Representatives of European Union delegation, Australian High Commission, Cabinet Division, Ministries of Food, LGRD and Cooperatives, Fisheries and Livestock, Women and Children Affairs, Labour and Manpower, Industries, Social Welfare and Economic Relations Division attended the meeting.

### JUJA withdraws VC's news boycott

The Jahangirnagar University Journalist Association (JUJA) yesterday withdrew their decision of boycotting the Vice Chancellor's news, reports UNB.

The journalists had started boycotting the VC's news since March 2, following a dispute over publishing a news item on kidnapping of a girl student.

After a long recess, the journalists withdrew their boycott, mediated by Prof Alauddin of Chemistry Department.

Another news adds: Jahangirnagar University Journalists' Association will hold a three-day workshop on journalism on June 26, 28 and 29.

Pro-Vice Chancellor Prof Abul Hossain will inaugurate the workshop while AAMS Arefin Siddiqui, Chairman of Journalism Department of Dhaka University will present the keynote paper.

### JCD blames BCL (S-P) for assault on 2 DU teachers

The Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) blamed pro-Awami League Chhatra League (BCL) for attacking two Dhaka University teachers on June 15, reports UNB.

The accusation came from a rally held in front of Jatia Press Club yesterday morning, organised by the central committee of JCD.

On June 15, some BCL activists reportedly damaged some cars and set ablaze a number of autorickshaws, during an anti-budget demonstration at Jagannath Hall.

During the incident, DU teachers — Prof Nazrul Islam, Director of Centre for Urban Studies and Prof Abdul Ahad, Chairman of Soil Science Department of Dhaka University — were injured.

The JCD rally also demanded immediate arrest and punishment of those responsible for the incident.

### Envoy to Mexico presents credentials

Bangladesh Ambassador to Mexico Humayun Kabir presented his credentials to Mexican President Zedillo Ponce de Leon on June 21 at the presidential palace in Mexico City, according to a message received in the city yesterday, reports BSS.

Kabir conveyed warm greetings of President Abdur Rahman Biswas and Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia to the Mexican President and best wishes for the government and people of Mexico.

President Zedillo also reciprocated his best wishes to President, Prime Minister and people of Bangladesh.

### Week-long IBA course in Ctg begins July 15

The Institute of Business Administration of Dhaka University is extending its services to Chittagong, the country's business capital, reports UNB.

The IBA will extend the service in response to growing demand for practical-oriented management courses by private, public and multinational organisations in the port city.

In the first phase of a series of programmes, it will organise a week-long course on 'Improving Selling Skills and Sales Promotion Techniques' from July 15.

The course will be held at Hotel Agrabad.

### BPC protests French N-test decision

The Bangladesh Peace Council (BPC) yesterday strongly protested the recent announcement by French government to resume testing of nuclear weapons in South Pacific and demanded immediate cancellation of the move, reports UNB.

"It is a complete violation of France's commitment taken together with 177 other countries at the end of the NPT Review Conference in New York last month," Ali Akhsad, BPC General Secretary and Asian Regional Coordinator of World Peace Council said in a statement.

### Mozambique leaders greeted

President Abdur Rahman Biswas has greeted Joaquim Alberto, President of Mozambique on the occasion of its national day today, reports UNB.

In a message to President Alberto, President Biswas hoped that the existing bonds of friendship and cooperation between Bangladesh and Mozambique would be further consolidated in the years ahead.

In a separate message, Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia has felicitated the Prime Minister of Mozambique, Pascoal Mocumbi, on the occasion.
