

72 govt-run blood banks in country

1.5m blind in country

Speakers at a workshop yesterday disclosed that more than 1.5 million people in the country are blind or visually handicapped, reports UNB.

"Every year the number is increasing due to poverty, illiteracy and lack of awareness," they said at the inaugural session of the workshop on "The Update in Ophthalmology" held in the capital.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Kamal Ibne Yusuf inaugurated the workshop as chief guest. Director of National Institute of Ophthalmology Prof A Q S M Harun and WHO representative Brigadier Shajahan Hafiz also spoke on the occasion.

The Health Minister in his speech said, a blind man is always a burden for the society. The rate of disability due to blindness in the country could be markedly reduced by providing primary eye care facilities to the rural people, he added.

Kamal Ibne Yusuf said the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has undertaken a project for prevention of blindness in collaboration with WHO and implementing it through National Institute of Ophthalmology.

Prof Harun said, National Institute of Ophthalmology has already covered almost 412 thana health complexes, 8 districts hospitals and 8 medical college hospitals by providing training on primary eye care.

At least one doctor and one nurse from each thana has already imparted training on primary eye care, Harun informed.

Sixty physicians from different hospitals and medical colleges attended the workshop.

479 posts of docs vacant in hospitals

The number of vacant posts of physicians in different hospitals of the country stood at 479 in March this year, the Parliament was told yesterday, reports UNB.

Replying to a question from Redwan Ahmed, Deputy Minister for Health and Family Welfare Sirajul Haq said the government is trying to fill up the vacant posts of physicians soon. The recruitment of doctors through the Public Service Commission is under way, he added.

Huq informed the House that there were 354 vacant posts of physicians in January 1990 and some 293 posts were filled up till March 1995. By this time, 181 doctors went on retirement.

Kidney Patients Welfare Assoc

The Kidney Patients' Welfare Association on Sunday hailed the government for exempting all kinds of duties on the dialysis and transplant materials of kidney in the budget proposed for 1995-96, reports BSS.

The association also urged all owners of dialysis centres to reduce the dialysis charges to a reasonable level for the benefit of the kidney patients.

Population growth rate 1.9 pc

The country's present annual rate of population growth is 1.9 per cent, according to the 1994 Health and Demographic Survey, reports UNB.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Kamal Ibne Yusuf said this in the Parliament replying to a question from Begum K J Hamida Khanam.

He said the growth of population was 3 per cent in 1971. It came down to 1.9 per cent as a result of implementation of family planning programmes.

The minister informed the House that nearly three lakh diabetic patients were undergoing treatment in different hospitals, including the BIRDEM.

CPR rate up by 5 pc

The Contraceptive Prevalence Rate (CPR) has increased to 45 per cent in 1993-94 from 40 per cent in 1991, reports UNB.

This was disclosed by Deputy Minister for Health and Family Welfare Sirajul Haque while replying a question from Sardar Shakhawat Hossain Bokul in the parliament yesterday.

Haque said an amount of Tk 333.84 crore was spent in the development budget and Tk 38.47 crore in the revenue budget for implementation of family planning programmes under Family Planning Department in 1994-95.
