Young man murdered


By Staff Correspondent A young man was allegedly murdered in a house at New Eskaton area in the city yesterday.

More rainfall predicted

Moderate to moderately heavy rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty or squally wind is likely to occur at most places over Dhaka, Barisal and Chittagong divisions and the regions of Bogra, Pabna and Rangpur during the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

Met office said moderate rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty wind may occur at many places over Khulna division and the regions of Raishahi and Dinaipur.

Heavy rain falls may occur at places over Dhaka, Chittagong and Barisal divisions and the regions of Bogra and Pabna in next 12 hours.

Day temperature may rise slightly over the country's southern parts and may remain nearly unchanged elsewhere. Meantime, Sylhet experienced the country's highest rainfall of 146 mm yesterday, Chittagong 79 mm, Dhaka 20, Mymensingh 34, Faridpur 14, Cox's Bazar 62, Comilla 18, Rangpur 37 and Jessore 38 mm.


