Tk 25 cr diabetic hospital complex in Ctg soon

CHITTAGONG, July 10: Chittagong branch of Bangladesh Diabetic Association has taken up a Tk 25 crore project for construction of a much needed diabetic hospital complex at Foy's lake here, reports BSS.

The diabetic hospital complex to be constructed on one acre of land in Foy's lake area will be implemented in phases, said A R Chowdhury, president of the Chittagong branch of BDA. He said that a 200-bed hospital and an administrative building would be constructed in the first phase. Construction work of the two buildings would start in August next.

Chowdhury said that a laboratory equipped with modern equipment and separate departments of surgery, medicines and gynecology would be constructed in the diabetic hospital complex. Facilities for treatment of diabetes related diseases would be created at the diabetic hospital complex, he added.

The Diabetic Association, Chittagong has been given one acre of land in Foy's lake area by Bangladesh Railway at a nominal cost and the land has already been developed for construction of the complex.
