The namaz-e-janaza of Emdad Hussain, a leading scientist and former member of the Bangladesh Atomic Energy Commission was held at the Baitul Mukarram national mosque yesterday after Zohr prayers, reports BSS.

Later, he was buried at the Shaheed Intellectuals Graveyard at Mirpur in the city. Emdad Hussain died at the National University Hospital at Singapore on Monday while undergoing treatment there. He was 60. He is survived by his wife, one son, two daughters and a host of relatives and friends.

Qulhwani of the deceased will be held at his residence at 'monti chelle' 302/2 Shamyoli (behind C and B office) today after Asr prayers.

Wahiduddin Ahmed, former principal of Hossain Shaheed Suhrawardy College died last night following a heart stroke. He was 58, reports BSS.

He had a distinguished career as Professor of History and received national award as best college teacher in 1993.

After his retirement he joined as chief coordinator of Society for the Care and Education of Mentally Retarded (SCEMRB) and held that position till his death. He left behind his wife, three sons and one daughter. He will be buried at the martyrs intellectual memorial graveyard at Mirpur. His qulhwani will be held tomorrow after Asr prayers at his 39/A Azimpur colony residence.

**BR's income from goods carrying up by 25 pc**

Revenue income of Bangladesh Railway from transportation of goods grew by 25 per cent in 1994-95 fiscal year over the previous year's earnings, reports UNB. According to provisional estimates placed in a meeting yesterday the western zone of railway registered a revenue growth of 39 per cent in goods transportation during the period.

The revenue earned by the eastern zone of the state-owned railway department was 14 per cent higher than that of fiscal 1993-94. The high-level meeting held at the conference room of the Railway Department reviewed various aspects of income and expenditures during the last fiscal year (1994-95).

**500 phones in city dead**

About 500 telephones in central Dhaka have been rendered dead due to faults in underground cables caused by road digging by different agencies, reports UNB.

A T&T Board press release said, the telephones of Kakrail, Naya Paltan, Faki-rapool, Motijheel colony and Bangabandhu Avenue under Moghbazar and Central exchange areas went out of order yesterday. It said, the restoration work has been taken.

**Moderate rainfall likely**
