Different student organisations yesterday condemned the terrorist activities of Jammaat-backed Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) at the Rajshahi University Saturday.

The Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), pro-Awami League Chhatra League (S-P) and Ganotantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO) held separate rallies on the Dhaka University campus protesting the incident.

At least 25 students were injured in a gunbattle between two student organisations from the Rajshahi University campus Saturday.

The student leaders called upon the students to stand against the Jammatabadi Shibir axis.

The students also demanded immediate arrest and trial of the responsible for the violence.

The JCD leaders addressing a rally in front of the DUCSU building said the Islami-Shibir axis was flexing their muscles through terrorism almost everywhere in the country.

The JCD leaders also urged the students to socially boycott the Jammatabadi Shibir axis.

They urged the RU authorities to reopen the university soon.

The JCD rally was addressed by Muniruzzaman.
