NEW DELHI, July 25: India's tea production declined by 18 per cent from a vear earlier to 159.8 million kilograms (351.6 million pounds) in the five months to May, officials said yesterday, reports AFP.

Exports declined by five per cent in the first five months of the year to 14.72 million kilograms (32.38 million pounds), said a spokesman for the state-run Tea Board said.

"But the value of tea exports went up 30 per cent from 27 million dollars to 35.5 million dollars in the same period," he said, because of higher prices.

Iran seizes \$ 2.5m from forex dealers

TEHRAN, July 25: The Iranian government has seized over 2.5 million US dollars from smugglers and foreign exchange dealers during the past two months, the official news agency IRNA reported yesterday, says Xinhua.

The report quoted a senior government official charged to fight hard currency smuggling as saying that the Information Ministry has intensified its campaign against smuggling of foreign exchange in the country.

Of the total seized foreign exchanges, the official said, about 700,000 dollars had been confiscated from smugglers and dealers in eastern Azarbaijan, 400,000 dollars in Khorasan, 450,000 dollars in Tehran, 160,000 dollars in Fars and the remaining sum in other provinces.

In May, the Iranian government announced a new measure to ban all transaction of foreign exchange outside the banking system and to require exporters, to return all their earned foreign exchange to the country's banning system.

The government also fixed the exchange rate for the greenback at 3,000 rials. warning that all dealers resorting to high rates would be seriously punished.

Although the black market of foreign exchange still exists, the rates of foreign ex change have sharply dropped, close to the rate of 3,000 rials announced by the government.

A total of 201461 shares worth Tk 37.84 million changed hands as against 141617 shares valued at Tk 19.40 million.


Total market capital also rose from Tk 47.30 billion to Tk 47.49 billion.

The six member states of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC), which seek to merge their oil-reliant economies under a 1982 pact, have made progress in unifying their tariffs on foreign imports and a customs union is now in sight, GCC secretary General Sheikh Fahim Al-Qassimi told the Omani

magazine Al-Haras. T am optimistic a unified customs tariff will see light before the end of this year

Gulf officials have said they have finished the classification of most foreign products which would be either taxed or exempted. More than 1.100 products would be listed under such a classifica-

GCC finance and economy minister are due to approve the list before they present it in its final form to their heads of state at their annual summit in Muscat in December, launching of the customs union is subject to endorsement by the GCC

A customs union was supposed to be set up five years after the 1982 agreement but it was held up by differences among members on the size and the common market be-, of the standard tariff.
