**Weather**

**Rain likely over vast area**

Heavy rainfall is likely at places over Dhaka, Khulna, Rajshahi and Barisal divisions during the next 12 hours, reports UNB.

The Met Office says moderate to moderately heavy rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty wind may occur at most places over Khulna, Rajshahi, Barisal and Dhaka divisions and at many places over Chittagong division.

The day temperature is likely to fall by 1-2 degree Celsius over Rajshahi, Dhaka, Khulna and Barisal divisions and may remain nearly unchanged elsewhere over the country.

In its outlook for tomorrow Met Office predicted little change. Giving extended outlook for another four days weathermen forecast that rainfall may increase at the end period.

The country's highest temperature 34.4 degrees Celsius was recorded at Sirimangal while the lowest 24.2 degrees at Barisal and Khepura.

The sun sets today at 6:44 pm and rises tomorrow at 5:26 am.
