**Thundershower likely**

Moderate to moderately heavy rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty wind is likely at most places over Dhaka, Barisal, Khulna, Chittagong and Rajshahi divisions during the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

Met Office says day temperature may remain nearly unchanged during the period over the country. In its outlook for subsequent two days weathermen predicted little change. Giving extended outlook for another five days Met Office forecast that rainfall activities is likely to decrease at the end period.

Meantime, Patuakhali experienced the highest 120 mm rain during the last 24 hours till 6 am yesterday. Faridpur had 78 mm rain. Rajshahi 76, Mymensingh 63, Chandpur 59, Barisal 55, Dhaka 40, Madaripur 34, Rangpur 31, Bogra 30, Rangamati 27, Bhola 23, Srimangal and Satkhira 20 each. Khepupara 18, Jessore 15, Majdicourt 14, Teknaf and Cox's Bazar 13 each. Sitakund 11, Feni 10, Dinajpur 8, Sylhet 7, Khulna 6, Kutubdia 5, and Chittagong, Comilla, Tangail and Ishurdi each had 4 mm shower during the period.

Country's highest temperature 33.2 degrees Celsius was recorded at Srimangal and the lowest 24.0 degrees at Dinajpur.

Sun sets today at 6:43 pm and rises tomorrow at 5:27 am.

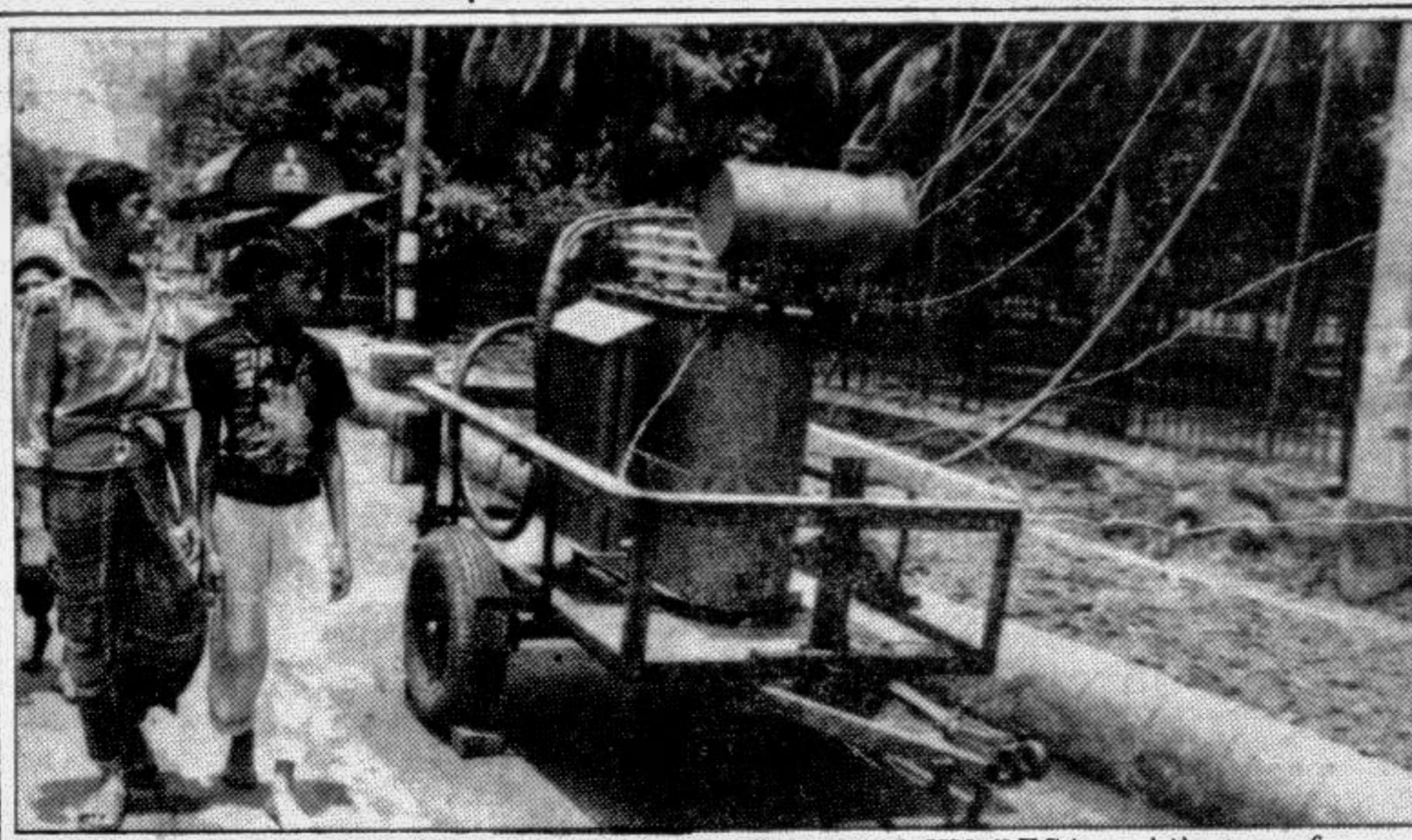
