Law clinic formally opens at DU

By DU Correspondent The Department of Law of Dhaka University has introduced a law clinic with a view to imparting practical knowledge of legal procedures to the students of law.

The clinic, funded by the Ford Foundation, was formally inaugurated in 1994 by Education Minister Zamiruddin Sirar. But the first batch of the clinic has started its classes from July 15 this year.

Dr Mizanur Rahman has been appointed the coordinator of the clinic.

The duration of each course is three months and the course will be attended by the fourth-year students only in two batches.

The clinic is equipped with a computer, a copier and an overhead projector for giving practical education to the students.

DU Journalism Dept Day observed

By DU Correspondent The Department of Mass Communication and Journalism of Dhaka University yesterday celebrated the department day, marking its 33rd founding anniversary.

The function began with a colourful chariot procession on the campus.

The students also decorated the department with colourful festoons, posters, and banners.

A discussion meeting, refreshers, reception and a prize-giving ceremony were held at the TSC auditorium in the afternoon.

Addressing the discussion Vice-Chancellor Prof Emajuddin Ahmed said, "Terrorism has gripped almost all the institutes of the country."

"Since we have no effective means to root terrorism from the campus, we have taken up some alternatives to face it by extending the course curriculum of the departments," the VC added.

"We have already introduced the integrated course system from the current academic session as part of this programme," he remarked.

He also informed that the DU would introduce either a four-year honours course or a two-year masters course in the university from the next academic session.

The meeting chaired by AAMS Arefin Siddique, was also addressed by Obaidul Haq, the former editor of the Bangladesh Observer, and prof QAIM Nuruddin.

"The classes will be conducted by noted practitioners. The present legal education in the universities of our country is aimed at only giving theoretical knowledge to the students," said a participant of the clinic adding "When the students go to the courts after completion of their four year course face a lot of procedural problems there."

"The law clinic will help us resolve these problems," he said with optimism. The Rajshahi and Chittagong universities have also introduced such courses with the help of the Ford Foundation.

"If the law clinic runs well, we will be able to produce efficient lawyers in our country," said Dr Mizanur Rahman.
