



last season and qualified for the UEFA Cup, and Celta of Vigo, who finished 13th, were the exceptions.

The LFP said Albacete and Valladolid, both relegated last season, would be reinstated to the top flight and Third Division clubs Getafe and Palamos would move up to the Second.

Both Sevilla and Celta can appeal against the ruling. Sevilla will be eligible to complete in the UEFA Cup


