

Foundation of two SSMCH hostels laid

Health and Family Welfare Minister Chowdhury Kamal Uddin yesterday said, the infrastructural development activities of Sir Salmullah Medical College are going on in fullswing at a cost of about Tk 16 crore, reports BSS.

He said, on completion of the development project there would be a tangible change in the quality of basic infrastructures and the standard of instruction.

The Health Minister was laying the foundation of two hostels one for the male students and the other for internee doctors of Sir Salmullah medical College in the city. Deputy Minister for Health Sirajul Hoque was also present on the occasion.

Addressing a gathering in the auditorium of the college, the Health Minister said, healthcare system in the country needs considerable development to meet the requirement of the teeming million.

Presided over by the principal of the college

Professor M Sakur the function was also addressed by Deputy Minister for Health Sirajul Hoque, vice president and general secretary of the students union Hasan Zafar Rifat and Saifullah Munshi.

The hostel for the male students will be constructed at a cost of Tk 1 crore 80 lakh and that of internee doctors hostel at a cost of Tk 2 crore 70 lakh. Besides, the construction of nuclear medicine department at a cost of Tk 10 crore and the other repair and renovation, and extension works of the hospital building will involve about Tk two crore.

Later, the Health Minister distributed prizes among the participants of out door games competition.

Clarification

The Dhaka Regional Scouts yesterday clarified a news published in The Daily Star created by UNB under the headline "Notice served on four Scouts leaders" on July 26.

In the clarification, the Scouts authorities said, Md Zahirul Haq was removed from the post of Regional Deputy Commissioner (Programme), Dhaka Regional Scouts as per the vested powers of the Scouts Secretary on 13-11-94 and Regional Commissioner's executive powers in 25-2-95.

Previously, a number of complaints against Haq's activities were lodged with the authorities which were proven to be against the morale of a scout. Secretary of the Dhaka Scouts Rezaul Karim Zoardar in a clarification said.
