The proliferation of highrise buildings in the city has accentuated the problems of children residing in the apartments of those buildings. The children of those places lead a cooped up life within the four walls of their apartments. In the forest of such tall buildings, we find provisions for such facilities as security arrangement, car parking space, standby electric generator, etc. but rarely some open space for children's playing activities.

The school children of the city will greatly benefited if government follows a policy as far as possible under which wherever in the city there is vacant government land adjacent to any educational institution, such land will be kept free for use for students of those institutions as playgrounds without allotting it for any other purpose.

According to observers we may effect some improvement in the existing state of things if appropriate measures are adopted to keep the existing open spaces free from encroachment and it is ensured that the atmosphere in these places is not vitiated through the presence of undesirable elements. This can be possible if the law-enforcing agencies. the Corporation and the RAJUK remain alert and active in their respective spheres. The existing dilapidated city parks in the different wards of the Corporation and elsewhere under management of other authorities may be rehabilitated for proper use by replacing the missing or disused playing equipments. What is more important is that sustained efforts need be made by local communities to display more civic sense and responsibility to maintain the restored facility for the children in their respective areas

The hole is unlikely to get much bigger because it is contained by strong winds circulating high in the atmosphere. But even at its present size it covers part of south America and the falkland (Malvinas) islands in the south Atlantic.

Fellow researcher Anna Jones warned that, despite the introduction of international controls on ozone-depleting cfc gases, the ozone hole was likely to appear each year 'for many years.'

The hole was discovered in 1985 by members of the British Antarctic survey, who have measured ozone levels for nearly 40 years.

Ozone depletion results from the presence of chlorine and bromine in the atmosphere which come from the emissions of humanmade chemicals such as cfcs. halon and methyl bromide.
