JAMALPUR, Aug 9: A total of 1,43,000 families were affectéd in 66 unions out of the total 68 unions in seven thanas of the district during the recent flood, according to official sources.

Some 11 people died including four children who drowned and another killed by snake bite during the pe-The sources said, 95,000

dwellings were completely destroyed while another 34.500 were partially damaged. Educational institutions numbering 430 were also affected in the flood. Standing crops on about

80 lakh acres of land were totally damaged and crops on 25,000 acres were partially damaged while 5,000 cattle were washed away.

The total losses of agricultural produce is estimated at Tk 350 crore.
