Call to change the concept of nursing

Speakers at a seminar here yesterday underscored the need for reorientation of nurses to the concept of nursing as a science and a profession, reports BSS. The seminar on 'conceptual reorientation of nurses to nursing' was formally inaugurated by Minister for Health and Family Welfare Chowdhury Kamal ibne Yusuf with a call to the country's nurses community to bring about a qualitative change in their services.

Organised by the Directorate of Health Services in collaboration with the World Health Organisation (WHO) the inaugural session was also addressed by Deputy Minister for Health and Family Welfare Md Serajul Haque, Health Secretary Syed Ahmed and Chief of WHO mission in Bangladesh Dr W Hardjotanojo as special guests. Held at Purbani Hotel, the inaugural session was presided over by the Director General of Health Services Prof Shamsuddin Siddiqui while Director of Nursing Services Begum Jahanara gave address of welcome.

Kamal ibne Yusuf, who was the chief guest on the occasion, said that the goal of the present government was to improve the quality of health services in the country through recognising the importance of contribution of the nurses in this endeavour.

Turning to the seminar subject the minister said, it is timely step to bring about changes in knowledge and conception of the nurses. He hoped that the seminar would evolve a new frame of reference for the nurses which is very significant for the improvement of nursing services.

Md Serajul Haque said that the overall nursing services had deteriorated due to the lack of accountability.

The three-day seminar is being attended by 450 nurses from all over the country.
