ALMERIA, SPAIN, Aug 29: Spanish fishermen yesterday stepped up a protest campaign against the slow pace of talks between Morocco and the European Union (EU) over fishing rights, fishermen's organisations said, reports AFP.

Fishermen in Almeria and Malaga, southern Spain, met at the ports Monday to blockade lorries en route to and from Morocco on board ferries, while those in Algerias plan to step up action from Tuesday.

In northwest Galicia they pledged to start another series of demonstrations which in the past have often ended in traffic chaos.

Drawing a parallel with the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) encompassing the United States, Canada and Mexico, Mahathir said thew East Asia Economic Caucus (EAEC) would also be a grouping within APEC.

"Hence, there is nothing to fear from the EAEC, Mahathir said as he opened an Asia-Pacific management consultants conference here. 'EAEC is intended to promote open regionalism and will be transparent."

The EAEC, first mooted by Ministers in Brunei earlier
