# Tribal insurgents continue to create violence

Two members of the Maran ding tribal insurgent were rounded up on Thursday last at Manikchhari, 6 kilometre North-West from district headquarters by the security forces while extorting tolls from the villages violating the truce for the eight times since the last peace talks held between PEJSS and

Government on July 12 last. Officials said, acting on a tip from the villagers, who have already fed up with the continuous extortion of tolls at an abnormally high rate by the tribal insurgents, the security forces caught redhanded the extortionists.

Ranjan Chakma, 29, and Dipon Dewan, 25, who confessed their active participation in insurgency, were handed over to Rangamati

Kotwali police. In another incident on the morning of August 31, an young mother with her tender son received bullet injumes in an exchange of fire between the security forces and the tribal insurgents at Laxmichhari of Khagrachhari hill district when the former was attacked with gun fire on their petrol by the later.

## Dairy farming in hardship

From Our Correspondent MEHERPUR, Sept 10: The

development of dairy farming in the district has been adversely affected for long due o lack of fodder. There are around one

hundred dairy farms having nearly one thousand improved varieties of cattles in the district. The daily production from these farms is roughly 15,000 litres of milk. But due to dearth of marketing facilities, the dairy farm owners are compelled to sell bulk quantity of milk to the tea shops at much cheaper rates while a small quantity goes to the private consumers at prices between taka 10.00 and taka 12.00 per litre.

The fodder crisis and its abnormal high prices have caused much sufferings and economic hardships to the dairy farmers all over the dis-Due to prolonged drought fodder crisis has taken a serious turn. As a result the prices of fodder like wheat, hav, oilcake, grass and paddy dust shot up thus enhanced the cost of cattle rearings' burdening the economic hardship of farmers.

The medical facilities are poor since the livestock offices and clinics at district and thana level are reportedly illstaffed and lacks, required medicines. The prices of the essential animal drugs manufactured in the country are very high while similar kind of Indian medicines are available at cheaper prices.

The artificial insemination centres also lacks required amenities and there are no experts in these centres which is greatly hampering smooth functioning of the artificial insemination programmes causing much sufferings to the farmers.

According to the experienced circles, required measures for marketing of the milk, supply of fodder by producing balanced food and adequate medical aids would help flourish dairy farmings

# Property worth Tk 11 crore gutted in six months

SYLHET, Sept 10: Property worth a total of about Taka 11 crore were gutted in 175 fire incidents in different areas of Sylhet Division during the last 6 months. The extent of loss is much more than that of the corresponding period of last year, an official source informed.

The incidents were caused by electric short circuit, burst of gas burners, cigarettes and candles, the source said. The biggest blaze during the period took place at Madhabpur thana headquarters under Habiganj district. The fire originated from electric short circuit burnt a good number of houses and business establishments there. The loss was estimated to be more than Taka 8 crore. However, the unofficial source claimed the loss to be worth about Taka 15 crore.

On August 28 property worth about several lakh taka were gutted in a bit fire that took place at Natun Bazar under Chhatak thana of

Sunamganj district. As many as 6 shops were burnt in the incident. All the shops were gutted before the fire brigade

The source however added that, establishment of 3 new fire stations in the division is on the process. These would be at South Surma and Jakiganj thana headquarters of Sylhet, and at Chhatak thana headquarters under Sunamganj district, he added.

# Creating artificial crisis

# Allegation against LP gas cylinder supply agents

From Our Correspondent

RANGPUR. Sept 10: The liquid petrol LP gas crisis has turned worst all over the district and its adjoining areas due to short supply and the malpractice of a section of traders in collaboration of the dealers.

At present, per cylinder of LP gas is sold by the dealers in between Taka 235 and Taka 240 as against its actual price at Taka 225.

But due to abnormal rise of the number of the consumers the sky demands of LP gas is experienced elsewhere across the district and taking this opportunity the dealers and the traders have been earning a lot of amount by selling the gas at exorbitant rates in black markets, it is alleged.

There are four dealers in the town areas and they are getting (supply) 4000 LP gas cylinders every month. But it is most surprising that most of these dealers and their sub-agents are selling 50 to 80 per cent gas cylinders out of their quotas which they received from the refineries.

There is none to resist or challenge their misdeeds and as a result they are freely doing the malpractices and selling the gas cylinders in black markets at much higher rates at Taka 300 to 400 per piece.

Some times the gas cylinders are not available even in the black markets due to short supply by the companies concerned to the utter sufferings of the consumers in general.

According to the local dealers and the representatives of different companies, there are over one lakh fifty thousand sets of gas ovens imported from India under OGL and sold to the consumers at cheaper rates some time back.

But the government did not taken up any step to enhance the production of gas cylinders in the country to meet its surplus demands which has caused an untold sufferings to consumers particularly those who depend on LP gas, it is alleged.

# Fishermen facing various problems in Jhenidah

JHENIDAH, Septio: More than one thousand fishermen in six thanas of Jhenidah district have been facing manifold problems in carrying out their ancestral profession for want of fund, scarcity of fishing materials like boats and nets it is learnt.

According to a statistical report, at least one thousand fishermen are engaged in the age-old profession in Jhenidah sadar, Sailkupa, Harinakundu, Kaligani, Kotchandpur and Mohespur thanas of the district. Now they are passing their days in extreme hardship due to shortage of capital. In absence of loan from the commercial banks, they are to borrow money from money lenders at a high rate to finance their business. it was learnt.

Talking to an old fisherman, Dhananjoy Majhee, of Sailkupa it was learnt that they were not in a position to draw loans from the commercial banks as they donot have sufficient lands to give mortgage to banks. As a result they are deprived of bank

Dhananjoy informed that for prolonged drought almost all the water bodies like canals, ditches, ponds became almost waterless which threw the fishermen in trouble. Now a fisherman can hardly catch an average 300 grams of fish a day which can not meet his family requirements. He also informed that almost all from their community were deprived of education facilities for decades together and that is why they can not be provided with jobs government sectors. Finding no other alternative, hundreds of fishermen left their localities.

A fish seller Shambhu Chand said that though the prices of fishes increased in the market, the fishermen are not really benefited with it as they are compelled to purchase the same at an abnormal rate due to shortage.

Local political leaders appealed to the commercial bank authorities including Bangladesh Krishi Bank to disburse loans among the fishermen at a lower rate to remove fish crisis and also to rehabilitate the fishermen at
