

Wolfensohn seeks new compact between WB, donor countries, South borrowers

WAHINGTON, Oct 11: James Wolfensohn, the World Bank's new President, called yesterday for a "new compact" between the bank, donor countries and developing country borrowers to ensure resources for the world's poorest were used efficiently, reports AFP.

He also stressed the need to "build capacity" in borrowing countries and to get the bank involved in the reconstruction of "societies emerging from chaos" — a reference to Bosnia and other "post-conflict" countries or territories.

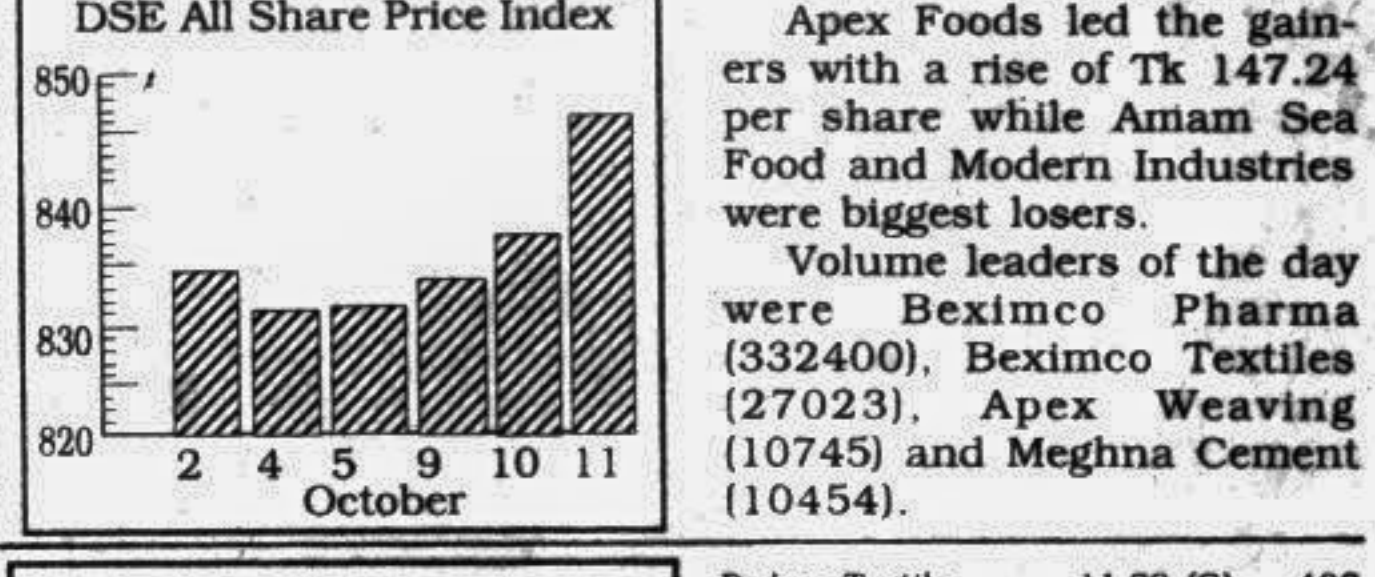
