from just 47 balls with two sixes and two fours but Kuiper was in strangely subdued mood, requiring 72 deliveries for his 50 before falling leg before.



Up-and-coming VFB Stuttgart got full value out of their international line-up with goals from Bulgaria's Krasimir Balakov, Brazilian Giovane Elber and Germany's Fredi Bobic in a 3-2 victory over Eintracht Frankfurt to move up to fourth.

#### **Border rescues** Queensland

BRISBANE, Australia, Oct 22: Allan Border and driving rain scuppered Victoria's chances of victory over champions Queensland in the final day's play in the Sheffield Shield cricket match here today, reports AFP.

Border, 40, the former Australian Test skipper. blunted Victoria's push to dismiss the home side in their second innings to set up a run chase for maximum points after taking a 121-run lead in the first innings.

Border hit a defiant unbeaten 70 as Queensland finished on 246 for six when rain intervened to force a draw.

Border had only paceman Michael Kasprowicz and the tail as batting partners with nearly three hours remaining, although Queensland captain Stuart Law later maintained they could still have shut the Victorians out.

Victoria, for whom opener Matthew Elliott and skipper Dean Jones scored centuries, have not won in Brisbane for 11 seasons. Queensland next take on

South Australia in another shield game beginning here on Wednesday. Queensland crushed South Australia by an innings and 101 runs in last season's final to win their first-ever shield.
