# Storing the Sad and yet **Edifying Memories**

It is a huge white house which looks almost like a knight's mansion. (who knows maybe it was, if not a knight's, then at least someone's with an elevated social position.

Ananda Bhaban on 5 Segun Bagicha is exactly such a house, seeing which you just wander back to by-gone-days. It is as if you have to think of the past the instant you enter its premises.

As if an unseen magnetic and no doubt nostalgic tug pulls you to the days when the girls of the house shared their secrets on roof tops in some lazy afternoons. Or the boys vibrant and idealistic debated politics and the country; the mothers and grandmothers making delicious foods and chewing betel leaves; while of course the more important business deals and finances were made and discussed in the father's library downstairs.

Ananda Bhaban may or may not have a romantic past but such a strong. sentimental longing for the times gone-by pulls you at the heart, the moment you step into its arena.

It has shown wears with time and is now nothing but a sweet reminder, of days that were, with loose bricks, broken walls, and shattered rooms. However the drama doesn't end in its shambles. It is now the proposed site for our long felt and much needed Muktijoddha Museum. A museum dedicated wholly to the liberation war, a place where those glorious days of history could be brought back to life and recreated .

"The work of establishing this Muktijoddha Smriti Museum to uphold the reality of our war of liberation in all its resplendent glories has been undertaken by The Muktijoddha Smriti Trust," informs Akku Chowdhury, one of the members of the Muktijoddha Smriti Trust.

This trust is an organization which is dedicated to honour the spirit of our struggle for freedom and committed to the spirit of the great war of liberation and preservation of memories of the war for posterity.

"For this purpose a two storied house has been rented in Segun Bagicha which will be thoroughly renovated to house the Museum," he says.

Leading architects, interior designers, artists, sculptors and museologists will work together to make it an appropriate museum. The work has already begun towards renovation and refurbishing.

The museum will project the history and heritage of the Bengalees by displaying different objects and disseminating information.

The movement for freedom will be

dark night of March 25, 1971 and mass killing, the resistance of the people against the Pakistan Army, aggression and the organized guerilla warfare, the refugee camps, the expatriate movement for liberation, cultural movement, the victory of the liberation forces and the brutal killing of the intellectuals by the agents of the defeated forces; the trust reports.

All items, displays and objects will be rotated and made interactive with the observers to make the museum a live one. The ground floor of Ananda Bhaban will exhibit things related to heritage and culture.It will also have, fossils, coins, puthies, scrolls and models of battlefields of Plassey, Sepoy Mutiny (1757-1857) Basher Kella, memorabilia of Master Da etc. This floor will also house struggles and movements taking place from '48 to '71. "Special arrangements for disabled freedom fighters has been made." So that they can visit the downstairs at least.

The upstairs will house incidents that took place from 25 March to 16 December 1971. While the top floor will show a vivid description of the night of 25th March recreated with sounds and light. "The grounds will be transformed into an auditorium which will also be rented to outsiders. There will also be a coffee shop. Sculptural pieces recreating the Boddhobhumi by Hamiduzzaman Khan will serve as a stark reminder of the systematic killing of our intelligentsia just before liberation.

Besides all these, there will be audiovisual displays and documents for references and research students. It is expected that there will be regular seminars and talks on the subject with scholars both national and international, who will be invited to participate. In addition, books and research papers will be regularly published and a newsletter will be brought out on a monthly basis, Chowdhury further adds.

The Museum will also make special arrangements to bring different schoolgoing students on certain days of the week to see the museum. There will be regular films and cultural programmes as well.

"Moreover if you want to become a participant in the museum's activity, you can be members," he says. There are sponsor members and charter members. Annual members have memberships renewable annually and volunteers can participate and volunteer their services and technical know-how.


