# Asia's overheating economies forecast to slow growth

MANILA, Nov 25: Overheating economies in China and most Asian tigers are forecast to slow to a more sustainable pace in the next two years, senior analysts from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) said yesterday, reports AFP.

Dowling told reporters that the pace of expansion in China, the NIEs, as well as Thailand and Malaysia was "unsustainable" at present

But he added that "overall, the growth rate is seven per cent for the region" and that "it's probably three times the growth rate for Latin America or Europe."

"So it's a very, very strong growth and it reflects adjustments to the overheating. We see it as a positive sign," he added.

Asked about the Manilabased ADB's projections beyond 1997, Dowling said "our crystal ball is very small." But he said that the trend

was for growth among emerging economies to slow as they developed.

"The trend towards slower growth in the NIEs is already a fact," Dowling said. "As economies mature, their growth rates tend to fall. It's like growing old," he said.

#### W Bengal firm to attract foreign investment: Basu

CALCUTTA, Nov 25: The West Bengal Chief Minister, Jyoti Basu, today assured a high-level Japanese delegation that his government was determined to improve the work culture and basic infrastructure in the state to attract foreign investments. reports PTI.

Basu, who was making the inaugural address on investment environment in West Bengal, during the 18th joint meeting of India-Japan standing committee, said, we have impressed upon the labour and the management to work toward attaining excellence in terms of productivity and quality.

The Japanese apprehensions about the work culture in the state was apparent from the fact that during the question-answer session only one question was asked to Basu when Elichi Matsumoto. Vice-Chairman of the standing committee of the Indo-Japan business cooperation committee and advisor to the Bank of Tokyo. asked what the West Bengal government was doing to improve quality of work in

Basu replied that his government was telling the trade unions that work culture would have to be improved to stand in the competitive world.

The Chief Minister said that his government realises the importance of the City of Calcutta, which can be developed into the gateway to the East, and hence the government was determined to improve its urban facilities.

## Russians facing flood of bad foreign food

MOSCOW, Nov 25: Russians are faced by a flood of bad foreign food, the government said yesterday. warning that almost half of imports, such as tea, fish, butter, cognac and sausages, were substandard, reports

The Russian Trade Committee's inspectorate or quality and consumer rights was quoted by Interfax news agency as saying that 76.6 per cent of imported tea was rejected in the first nine months of this year.

The next biggest culprit was cognac, 66.4 per cent of which was rejected, followed by 48 per cent of fish, and 42.4 per cent of butter which was often fat or mar garine being passed off as

real butter. Sausages, canned products and drinks also left a sour taste in state inspector's nouths, according to the re-

The commission said dealers were deliberately importing cheap foodstuffs without bothering to check for quality.

Earlier this week. Prime Minister Viktor Chernomyr din said he was worried by the domination of foreign consumer goods in Russia. which still has massive quality and distribution problems of its own.

More than 50 per cent of consumer goods sold in Russia and up to 80 per cent of Moscow's food are imported. officials said.
