If a farmer decides to take a policy of 50,000 rupees for fire and burglary, 30,000 rupees for cattle and 25,000 rupees for janata personal accident insurance and 1,000 rupees for pedalcyle, he will have to pay a premium of 314 rupees per year.

### China still deems APEC summit review unfair

BEIJING, Nov 26: Beijing said Saturday that its acceptance at the recent APEC summit in Osaka of the US right to keep China's most favoured nation (MFN) under annual review was only made to secure the summit's success, reports AFP.

Consequently, China still of APEC," he said. deems the annual review to be highly unfair and discriminatory, and a policy that other countries should condemn, said Li Enhong, the head of the Chinese delegation at the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) meeting.

The action agenda adopted by APEC members in Osaka included a section on non-discrimination which. after lengthy negotiation. contained a clause that allows Washington to continue its MFN review.

Beijing had pushed hard for a comprehensive ban on any trade policies that might

be seen as discriminatory. "China accepted the Osaka agreement on non-discrimination only to ensure the summit meeting's success." Li was quoted as saying by the China Daily.

He also urged "interested parties" to work harder to find a permanent resolution of the MFN issue.

### SIA orders for \$12.7b 77 Boeing

Singapore Airlines (SIA) has placed an order for 77 Boeing B777 aircraft worth 12.7 billion US dollars, including the cost of spares and spare engines, says a press release.

Of the 77 aircraft, 34 are on firm order, with 43 on option. Six of the firm orders and ten of the options are intended for Singapore Aircraft Leasing Enterprise (SALE) the leasing associate of SIA. based in Singapore.

SIA has selected Rolls Royce Trent engines to power the 61 Boeing B777s intended for SIA. No decision has been taken yet by SALE. on the engines for the 16 aircraft they intend to buy.

The decision on the latest order was reached after seven months of extensive studies and discussions with the aircraft and engine manufacturers.

### Argentine move for Falkland oil rights

BUENOS AIRES, Nov 26: Argentina is calling for international bidding to explore for oil in waters around the Falkland Islands, known here as the Malvinas, officials said vesterday.

Argentina is seeking international bidding and exploration and exploitation rights in seven maritime sites, government sources told AFP

sites comprise 55,000 square kilometres (22,000 square miles) situ ated between Santa Cruz and Tierra Del Fuego provinces, including Patagonia, in the southern tip of the country.

Bidding was not included in the cooperation plan between London and Buenos Aires agreed to in New York this year

Argentina and Britain fought a brief, but bloody war in early 1982 over the archipelago, which is believed to contain rich oil deposits.

Britain sent a taskforce to the region after Argentina invaded the mostly British-inhabited islands, forcing an Argentine surrender.


