Govt spending more in madrasa edn

The government is spending more in madrasa education than in secular secondary education, according to a study conducted by a local research organisation.
The government allocation for madrasa students during the academic year 1995 was Tk 4273 per student, whereas only Tk 1979 was allocated for a student in secular government school, a study by the Bangladesh Bureau of Education Information and Statistics (BANBEIS) showed.
The figures were revealed Sunday at a seminar on education for the disadvantaged, organised by the Association for Realisation of Basic Needs (ARBAN), at the Engineers' Institution auditorium in the city.
