### George sets new world mark

MELBOURNE, Nov 30: Australian Emma George broke the wold record in the women's pole vault at Olympic Park here Thursday. just 12 months after taking up the discipline, reports George cleared 4.25 me-

tres to better the mark of 4.23m set by China's Sun Caiyun early this month. The 21-year-old Mel-

bourne athlete is only the fifth Australian athlete to hold a world record. George, a former long

jumper who turned to pole vaulting 12 months ago, said she had been attempting to break the record for the past few months. "It's such a relief I've fi-

nally achieve it," she said. "In such a young sport, the sky's the limit for me."

Women's pole vault is not yet an Olympic sport but George is hoping it will be accepted into the 2000 Sydney Olympics.

## Weah voted Africa's best

JOHANNESBURG, Nov 30 Liberian international George Weah has been voted the best African footballer of 1995, the Confederation of African Football (CAF) said on Wednesday, reports Reuter.

The 29-year-old AC Milan striker finished top of a poll of members of CAF's technical and press committees with 45 points, 15 more than second-placed Japhet Ndoram of Chad.

# Giants battle for 8th title

Defending champions Abahani Krira Chakra and arch-rivals Mohammedan Sporting Club

will fight it out for the 16th Damal Summer cricket trophy at the Dhaka Stadium today. The match, the eleventh between the two top crowd-pulling teams in the country in the season's curtain-raiser meet, will commence at 9 am.

Bangladesh Television will telecast the 50 over-a-side affair live while Radio Bangladesh will broadcast ball-toball commentary.

The tournament is organised annually in memory of Mazharul Islam Damal, an ace cricketer of the country who had the honour of representing the then East Pakistan in the Pakistan national team the only Bengali to do so.

Along with the champions' medal, which is provided each year by the family of the deceased cricketer, this year there will be an additional prize for the man-ofthe-match which will be awarded in memory of Asif Omar Belim. Asif, a promising spinner who was the second highest wicket-taker in last season's top level cricket

with 33 scalps to his credit, died of a cardiac arrest on March 8 this year.

In the two heavyweights' ten battles since the introduction of the tourney in 1979, the success-scale can hardly he said to be in the balance with Abahani winning seven times to Mohammedans' three. Among them, five of the former's triumphs have come in the final while all of the latter's have been in the title-deciding stage.

The two first met in the final of the second edition of the meet in 1980 when Abahani lifted the trophy for the

first time defeating their opponents by 38 runs. The last time the two met also saw a similar result with Abahani coming out winners by 32

runs in last year's semifinal. The rivalry apart, both the local giants have lifted the crown seven times each with Mohammedans reaching the final a record 13 times while Abahani have fought for the hounours ten times.

Meanwhile, Abahani have called on the services of Indian Test duo of Ajay Jadeja and Aashish Kapoor for today's match.

# Ijaz shows 'em how to bat

SYDNEY. Nov 30: Pakistan number three Ijaz Ahmed bo-Istered the tou-

flagging morale with an unbeaten century after Australian legspinner Shane Warne made a dramatic return to Test action in the third and final Test today, reports Reuter

ljaz occupied the crease for six minutes short of six hours to finish on 101 not out and earn the distinction of becoming the first Pakistan batsman to reach triple figures during the series.

At close of play on the first day at the Sydney Cricket Ground, Pakistan were 231 for four, with Basit Ali the other not out batsman on

eight. ljaz reached his third Test century, all against Australia, by cutting a short-ball from fast bowler Craig McDermott to the point boundary just before the close. His teammates in the pavilion gave him a standing ovation.

Warne shrugged off the lingering effects of a broken toe sustained 13 days ago to claim the wickets of opener Rameez Raja and number four Inzamam-ul Haq.

Warne, who passed a fitness test on Wednesday, bowled 27 overs and appeared untroubled by the injury.

Pakistan, completely outplayed in losing the first two Tests, bated with grim determination after captain Wasim Akram won the toss in warm, overcast conditions.

ljaz, who came to the wicket in the first over of the

day after the fall of opener Aamir Schail for four, hit two sixes and 13 fours in an innings 266 balls.

It was a rare display of concentration and patience by a Pakistan batsman in the final match of a bitterly disappointing tour.

Warne broke his left big toe while batting during the first innings of the second Test and played no further part in the match. He finished today with figures of two for 44.

Rameez fell for 33 before lunch when he checked a pull shot only to loft a simple catch to Michael Slater at mid-on.

Warne struck again in his third spell when lnzamam was caught by wicketkeeper lan Healy of a bottom edge with his score on 39. McDermott made the first

breakthrough when Sohail edged a catch to Mark Waugh at second slip off third ball of the innings. Fast bowler Glenn Mc-

Grath took the fourth wicket to fall. He removed Salim Malik for 36, his highest score in four innings on tour, during the last session.

Malik, whose tour has been overshadowed by a bribery scandal and disrupted by injury, was jeered by a small first-day crowd of 11.000 as he walked to the wicket.

Malik survived his en counter with Warne, one of three Australian players to

accuse the former Pakistan captain of 'offering bribes'. Malik was cleared of the charges by an internal inquiry before leaving on tour.

Pakistan made three changes from the side beaten by 155 runs in the second Test in Hobart 10 days ago. dropping opener Salim Elahi. pace bowler Mohammad Akram, and wicketkeeper Moin Khan.

They were replaced by Malik, who missed the second Test because of a cut hand, off-spinner Saglain Mushtag and Rashid Latit .

Australia named an un changed side for the third time in the series.

## Italy first to confirm an Olympic berth

TOKYO, Nov 30: World champions Italy became the first team to secure a place at next year's Atlanta Olympics when they defeated South Korea for their ninth straight win at the men's World Cup volleyball on Thursday, reports AFP.

The 15-13, 15-7, 15-10 in Chiba gave Italy one of three automatic places for Atlanta regardless of the outcome of their remaining two matches.

"We were tired after playing three matches in Sendai, but Andrea Zorzi's blocking was wonderful," said Italian coach Julio Velasco, who gave captain Andrea Gardini a rest

Korean coach Choi Jong-Ok said, "We couldn't get the ticket for the Olympics, but I used a lot of rookies in this match to gain experience. It was too bad that we have some injured players."

The top three finishers, except the United States. who qualify as hosts, will be eligible for Atlanta. The Netherlands, Brazil, Japan and Cuba could get the other two spots.

The Netherlands overwhelmed China 15-10, 15-10, 15-3, to trail Italy with a 7-2 win-loss record, while Canada defeated winless Tunisia 15-12, 15-5, 15-12.

South Korea and China stood with 3-6 and Canada with 2-7.

### Kuwaitis won't face Iraqis

KUWAIT. Nov 30: Kuwaiti football club Kazemah announced Wednesday it would refuse to play Iraqi club Al-Talabah in the semifinal of the Asian Cup on December 22 in Japan, reports AFP.

Kazemah official Sulaimane Al-Adassani said the refusal by his club to play the match was a great honour for all Kuwaitis.

He added that during seven months of occupation by Iraqi troops (August 1990 to February 1991), the Iraqis transformed Kazemah into a concentration camp where they tortured and massacred the sons of Kuwait.

The Iraqi regime still holds more than 600 Kuwaiti prisoners, including three Kazemah players, Al-Adassani continued.

the English League Cup with a 1-0 victory in their fourthround clash on Wednesday. reports Reuter Defender Steve Watson

scored the winner 13 minutes from the end to send Newcastle into the quarterfi nals and eliminate Liverpool. who won the League Cup for a record fifth time when they beat Bolton 2-1 in last season's final First Division Wolver

last eight after Reading beat Premier league Southampton 2-1 on Tuesday. Former England striker

Ian Wright scored on his return from suspension to lead Arsenal to a 2-1 victory over Sheffield Wednesday, the club they beat in both the FA Cup and League Cup finals in 1993.

Belgian international Marc Degryse put Sheffield Wednesday in front at Arsenal in the 16th minute but Wright equalised five minutes before the interval from the penalty spot with the 250th goal of his career after Paul Merson far had been brought down in the area

John Hartson clinched Arsenal's winner in the 64th minute.

It was the 15th Cup meet ing between the two sides in 45 years and Arsenal have yet to lose

Leeds added to the woes of Blackburn beating the premier league title holders 2-1 on the day the European football union (UEFA) said it was banning Blackburn's England internationals Graeme Le Saux and David Batty for two European matches for grossly unsporting conduct after exchanging blows during a Champions League

game in Moscow last week. Brian Deane opened the Leeds account in the 21st minute and Ghanaian fellow striker Anthony Yeboah added the second eight minutes later.

Ireland defender Garv Keely headed an own goal six minutes after the interval to reduce the Leeds lead but it was not enough for Blackburn, who have struggled in their domestic title defence and lost their way in the European Cup with four defeats in the five Champions' League matches they have played so

Tomas Brolin, Sweden's World Cup playmaker, performed well on his first appearance in the Leeds starting line-up since his 4.5 million pounds sterling (6.9 million dollars) signing from Italian First Division Parma.

Newcastle progressed to the quarter finals for the first time in 20 years thanks to Watson, who scored with a great left foot chip 16 minutes after he had come on as replacement for England striker Les Ferdinand.

Ferdinand had been injured in an accidental clash of heads with Liverpool defender Mark Wright.
